Introduction

Immediately after the reaccreditation by NAAC with 'A' grade, the IQAC, Islamiah College (Autonomous) Vaniyambadi has started the practice of conducting Internal Academic Audit (IAA) from 2014-15 with the help of Two Internal Academic Auditors namely Dr. S. Raja Mohamed Kamil, Associate Professor of Chemistry and Dr. A. Noor Mohamed Associate Professor and HOD of Commerce. The period of Internal Academic Audit for which the present report has been submitted is from 01-4-2015 to 31-3-2016 i.e., the academic performance of two semesters. The Internal Academic Audit has been submitted under criteria wise covering all important aspects. The IAA process was started on 30-3-2016 and completed on 31-3-2016. The Internal Academic Auditors have prepared the report by personally visiting all the departments and collecting the necessary information relating to their respective departments.

CURRICULUM DESIGN

The fundamental and foremost part of academic structure is designing of curriculum. Curriculum is designed with the aim of keeping pace with the modern day advancement, technological changes, changing needs of the society and industry as well as providing employment opportunities to the students. The autonomy of this college gives free hand to design our own curriculum to fulfill the above requirements and thereby enabling us to produce graduates with outstanding skills, knowledge and leadership qualities to face the competition successfully.

In B.Com, the new papers such as 'Business Computer Application' a full fledged practical paper and Tally Accounting have been introduced. In M.com, Corporate Laws and E-Commerce papers have been introduced.

In B.Com (C.A), the new topics like the recruitment procedure of UPSC, TNPSC, RRB and training methods of leading companies like TCS, WIPRO, PEPSI are included in the syllabus.

In B.Com (F&A), the curriculum design concentrates on training the students in the field of financial services, accounting and auditing.

In BBA, the most wanted subjects like ‘Advertisement and Salesmanship’ and ‘Tally and Export Management’ have been introduced.

In B.A (History), the papers including ‘General Knowledge and Awareness’ and ‘Civil Services and other competitive examinations’ have been introduced in III and IV semesters respectively.

In B. Sc (Mathematics), the papers titled ‘Hands on training with computer’ and ‘Software technique’ have been introduced in the curriculum.

In both the under graduate and post graduate courses of Chemistry, practical skills are imparted by introducing semester wise practical examinations. Industry oriented topics have become the part of syllabus. Modern teaching methods through multimedia classes are being adopted.

In Biochemistry course, ‘Human anatomy and Physiology’ and ‘Bioinformatics’ papers have been introduced at under graduation level. In post graduation, ‘Pharmacology and Toxicology’ and ‘Ecology and Evolution’ have been introduced.

In Biotechnology, the papers like ‘Environmental Biotechnology’, ‘Endocrine Technology’ and ‘Immunology’ have been introduced. In M.Sc Biotechnology, the optional subjects such as ‘Advanced Biochemistry’ and ‘Molecular Genetics’ have been introduced.

In Tamil, ‘Science and Computer Tamil’ has been introduced to the II year non major students.

‘An introduction to American culture’ is the paper newly introduced by the department of English. An objective type book for value education has also been published.

The department of Hindi has introduced ‘Basic Hindi’ for non Hindi students in the III and IV semesters.

INTER DISCIPLINARY PROGRAMMES

The Commerce department conducts the Inter disciplinary programmes like 'E-Commerce and Footwear technology' to the students of all disciplines. The paper titled 'General Commercial Knowledge and Business Correspondence' has been introduced to the students of B.A History.

BBA department continues to offer Management subjects dealing with Training and development of Employees to the students of other departments.

B.Com (CA) offers Income Tax as non-major subject to BBA students to make them aware of basic principles of IT.

History department continues offering Indian National Movement and Indian Political System as non-major papers for B.Com and B.Com (FA) students.

The department of Mathematics conducted inter-disciplinary research that led to the award of PhD degree to Dr. H. Faheem Ahmed, HOD of Computer Science.

The Physics department continues to offer subjects like 'Fundamentals of Electrical and Electronic Measurements' and 'Maintenance of Home Appliances' as non-major subjects for the students of B.Com (FA) and B. Sc (Mathematics) students.

The Computer Science department offers 'Introduction to IT' and 'Internet and its Applications' for III semester and IV semester students of other department students.

The Department of Chemistry conducted Inter disciplinary research with the Physics department leading to the award of PhD degrees to Dr. J. Asgar and J. Mohamed Ali Associate and Assistant Professors of Physics respectively.

Biochemistry department continues to offer 'Diagnostic Biochemistry' paper for B. Sc Biotechnology students.

The department of English offers 'English for Communication' for B. Sc Computer Science students of III Semester and 'Business writing in English' for IV semester students.

EXAMINATION REFORMS

The CIA Test I was conducted 3 sessions per day, thereby saving 2 working days for teaching.

Direct Entry of Internal Assessment Marks in the computers through intranet facility is implemented. This has saved stationery up to 86%.

It has been proposed to conduct End Semester Valuation simultaneously during the End Semester Examinations from April 2016 onwards. This will enable the COE to publish the results in a very short span of time.

It has been decided to conduct OMR based examinations for Environmental Studies and Value Education Courses.

Question papers for the end semester Practical Examinations have been arranged and supplied by the Office of the Controller of Examinations.

The Internationally renowned book house ‘Springer’ has published a Book entitled “Ascidians in Coastal Water” authored by Dr.H. Abdul Jafar, Assistant Professor of Bio-Chemistry.

GOOD PRACTICES OF THE DEPARTMENTS

The department of Commerce maintains the Departmental library containing books of 140 titles. These books are being lent for the poor students to prepare for examinations as well as for instant references.

ICT enabled classes are being taken to make students understand the concepts with ease by using power point presentations and videos.

B.Com (CA) department conducts regular parent-teacher meeting to appraise the performance of the individual students. The practice of News paper reading is inculcated among the students to know the developments in stock exchange and other markets.

B.Com (FA) department encourages their students to learn computer technology by using laptops.

The department of History offers counseling to the students regarding filling up of applications for competitive examinations and for preparations.

The department of Mathematics is guiding the students to appear for competitive examinations conducted by UPSC, TNPSC, UGC, CSIR etc. It also conducts remedial classes for the slow learners.

In the Physics department, a corpus fund has been created from contributions from the staff members to help the deserving poor students.

The department of Computer Science sends SMS alerts to the parents of the students about their attendance. It provides internet facility for students` during leisure hours.

The department of Chemistry conducts regular remedial classes for poor performers and also run coaching classes for all competitive examinations. The students are encouraged to involve the activities of the forum, Rural Society for the Advancement of Chemistry, (RUSAC). The PG students are given first hand information and training to operate the sophisticated instruments in the laboratories, FIST I and FIST II.

The Biochemistry department utilizes the funds obtained from the alumni for the purchase of chemicals, kits etc. This department also plays the video lectures of the eminent persons during the leisure hours.

STUDENT ATTENDANCE

A minimum of 75% attendance is required to appear for both theory and practical examinations. The students with 65-74% of attendance are listed under shortage of attendance and they need to pay condonation fee to become eligible to write the examinations. The students who have 55-64% are detained and those with less than 55% have to redo the course.

Nearly 85% of the students have attendance over 75%. Almost all the remaining students pay the condonation fee and write the examination.

RESULT ANALYSIS

The overall results of the students in all the departments are fairly good. However, the papers which need to be concentrated are mentioned here.

BBA April-2015 In first year, the result of ‘Business Mathematics and Statistics II’ is 32% and in I BBA the results of ‘Principles of Management’ is 24%. During the Nov-2015 Examination, In Ist year BBA, the pass percentage of ‘Principles of Management’ is 24% and that of ‘Business Organization’ is mere 24%.

B.COM (CA) April-2015 the paper, ‘Corporate Accounting II’, the result was 46%.**Nov-2015-** In the first year ‘Principles of Management’, the percentage of result is 40%. In the second year, the paper, ‘Data base management system’ has the pass percentages of 11%. In Third year, ‘Banking law & practice’ -has the pass percentage of 31%.

B.COM (FA) Nov-2015 In the First year, the student results are less than 40% in ‘Hindi’, ‘Business Communication’, ‘Industrial Law’ and ‘Indian Economy’. In Second year B.Com (FA), in IV semester papers, ‘Indian Economy’, ‘Corporate Accounting II’ and ‘Indian Political system’ the results are less than 40%.

BEST PRACTICES

The library has established a separate Virtual Library for the benefit of the students and research scholars.

SPORTS

- The sports activities of the college are hectic inside and outside campus. The students participate inter-collegiate and University level tournaments in all disciplines of sports and games. - The Department of History has the plan to celebrate the Golden Jubilee by organizing a Two-day national Seminar and to bring out the proceedings with ISBN through the sponsorship from ICHR and from Alumni.
- The Department of Mathematics has the plan to conduct International conference and to sign the MoU with research institutions.
