MINUTES OF 20th ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING

The 20th Meeting of the Academic Council of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi was held on 09-04-2025 at 11-00 a.m. through blended mode. The meeting commenced with invocation by **Dr. C. Mohamed Faheem,** Associate Professor of History.

Mr. L. M. Muneer Ahmed, the Secretary and Correspondent of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi, welcomed the members of the Academic Council and appreciated the efforts of all stakeholders in the holistic development of college. He lauded IQAC for organising several programmes to students and staff members for enhancing quality. He acknowledged the contribution of all members of the Academic Council in their tenure and expressed profound gratitude for their presence and suggestions.

Dr. T. Afsar Basha, chairman of the Academic Council, read the minutes of the 19th Academic Council Meeting held on 30-05-2024, which were approved by the house.

Dr. Syed Tahir Hussainy, Member Secretary, Academic Council & Vice-Principal (Administration), moved the resolution that the Regulations and Schemes of Examinations for UG Degree Programmes for the semester V & VI as given in Regulations and Schemes - Volume XIX be adopted for implementation from the Academic Year 2025-2026 for UG Students admitted from the Academic Year 2023-2024, and was approved.

Chairman, Board of Studies of all Departments moved the resolution for adoption of Syllabi for V & VI Semesters of all UG Degree Programmes for students admitted from Academic Year 2023-2024 as given in the Syllabi Book – Vol. XIX and it was resolved to approve the same unanimously.

- **Dr. C. Mohamed Faheem**, Associate Professor of History, moved the resolution for adoption of Syllabi of Certificate Courses offered by Departments of English, Commerce, Business Administration and Commerce (Computer Applications), as given in the Syllabi Book Vol. XIX, from the Academic Year 2025-26, and it was resolved to approve the same.
- **Dr. P. K. Mohamed Imran,** Associate Professor of Chemistry, moved the resolution for adoption of Syllabi of Certificate Courses offered by Departments of Physics, Chemistry, Biochemistry, Biotechnology and Computer Science, as given in the Syllabi Book Vol. XIX, from the Academic Year 2025-26, and it was resolved to approve the same.
- **Mr. S. Mohammed Naseeruddeen**, Controller of Examinations, moved that the Examination Manual Vol. XVIII, be adopted for implementation from April 2025 Even Semester Examinations and was unanimously approved by all the members.
- **Mr. S. Mohammed Naseeruddeen**, Controller of Examinations, placed the results of the Autonomous Even Semester Examinations April 2024, and Odd Semester Examinations November 2024, for ratification and approval and it was resolved to ratify and approve the same by the august House unanimously.
- Dr. A. Khaleequzzaman, Assistant Professor of Commerce and joint Co-ordinator, IQAC, brought forward the resolution for implementing UGC guidelines for incorporating Indian Knowledge System in Higher Education Curricula by introducing courses to that effect (for 5 % of the total credits of a Degree Programme, 50 % of which is to be aligned with Major Stream Study). **Dr. J. Srinivasan,** External Expert, welcomed the suggestion and added that the Indian Knowledge System can be integrated even in Student Projects / Internships, as suggested by UGC. **Dr. B. Kathiresan,** University Nominee, informed that more details

about the Courses and Topics are available on the Indian Knowledge System website

(www.iksindia.org) which can be referred to, while drafting the curriculum. It was

unanimously approved to implement the same in next revision of Regulations, Course

Structure and Syllabi.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, External Expert, enquired about the inclusion of Naan

Mudhalvan Courses in curriculum, to which Dr. T. Afsa Basha, Chairman, Academic

Council, replied that, the scheme has not been extended to Aided Autonomous

Colleges, and issue has been raised by the college in the Meeting with the Honourable

Education Minister, Government of Tamilnadu. He assured that once the government

extends the scheme to Aided Autonomous Colleges, it shall be integrated into the

curriculum.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, External Expert, congratulated the college for improvements

in last 5 years and commended the college for being the first college in the region to

adopt curriculum based on TANSCHE Model Curriculum, and now for, considering

inclusion of IKS in curriculum, within just few days of receiving the communication

from UGC.

The meeting came to end at 1.00 p.m. with a formal vote of thanks by the

Dr. Shaik Khader Nawaz, Vice-Principal [Academics] and Co-ordinator, IQAC.
