#### **INTERNAL ACADEMIC AUDIT REPORT 2023-2024**

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi has started the practice of conducting Internal Academic Audit (IAA) since the Academic Year 2014-15. Dr. K. Anandaratchagan, Head & Associate Professor of Chemistry and Dr. V. Mahmudul Hasan, Assistant Professor of Commerce, were appointed as Internal Academic Auditors for the Academic Year 2024-25. The present IAA report has been prepared by Internal Auditors for the Academic Year 2023-24 (from 01.06.2023 to 31.05.2024) covering, two semesters of the academic year. This IAA report is submitted as per the IQAC criteria encompassing all important parameters. The IAA was conducted on 4th July 2024.

During the Internal Academic Audit the Internal Auditors personally visited all the Academic Departments and Units of Students Support Services to verify the records and collect the required information. #### ACTIVITIES OF STUDENT SUPPORT SERVICES

The Islamiah College, Vaniyambadi maintains around 19 support services for the benefit of student community. The activities of various support services are given in detail.

#### 1. CONTROLLER OF EXAMINATIONS

The office of the COE has conducted internal tests periodically for the award of internal marks to the students of Islamiah College by following the centralized examination system. The tests are conducted by following a fixed schedule through setting question papers and valuing the answer papers by the faculty members of various departments. The end semester examinations are conducted in a centralized manner with a schedule and by receiving question papers from the external examiners. The practical examinations for the science department are conducted under the supervision of an external examiner. The answer scripts for the UG courses are valued by internal examiners and for the PG courses the valuation is done by the external examiners.

The rules and regulations of the college in conducting the examinations, valuation of the answer papers and publication of results are strictly followed. The students are also given an opportunity to go for revaluation and instant examination. The students who have completed their courses were awarded with their degrees through the graduation day celebrations in a grand manner. In the academic year 2023-24, nearly 1880 students have received their degrees in three phases on 12<sup>th</sup>, 20<sup>th</sup>, and 26<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Results are published immediately after the paper evaluation. The office of the COE coordinates in conducting examinations for value added certificate courses for UG/PG students and course work examinations for research scholars of Islamiah College.

An Orientation Programme for explaining CBCS – Choice Based Credit System and Examination System to the first year students of UG programmes was conducted on 23.06.2023 and 27.06.2023. The COE office plays a vital role in the designing of the curriculum for various courses through the conduct of BOS meetings and meetings of other statutory bodies.
