



After properly applying the reclamation methods, the lab discharge turned into clean water where fish culture is done.

With the motive of imparting the theoretical knowledge and to provide Hands on experience, the PG & Research Department of Chemistry, organized one-day workshop on "Treatment and Reclamation Methods of Lab Discharge" on Saturday, 20.03.2021. The students, scholars and staff members of our college and from neighboring colleges participated.


