



ENVIRONMENTAL PROMOTION POLICY


Islamiah College (Autonomous), a century old institution, shows keen interest in preserving, protecting and improving the quality of environment. The College strives to eliminate or reduce all forms of pollutions deteriorating environmental quality. The College regularly organizes various programmes, inside and outside the college, to promote awareness about Environment Protection. The college encourages all the Departments, Staff and Students to follow the Environmental Policy of the College.

Policy for Environmental Promotion:

- Adopting the Policy of 3R's for wastes viz., Reduce, Reuse and Recycle.
- Maintaining Clean and Green Campus
- Adopting Swachh Bharat Abhiyan as a part of the clean campus initiative
- Creating awareness on planting of trees
- Conducting Tree Plantation Programmes inside and outside the College as a part of green campus initiative
- Providing waste collection points at appropriate places for Solid and Liquid Wastes.
- Trash bins have been fixed in the campus for the collection of waste and unloaded in a central dump yard.
- Employing sanitary workers for maintaining cleanliness and carry out the task of disposal of obsolete and unusable items, preventing accumulation of junk.
- Segregating Biodegradable and Non Biodegradable wastes before disposal.
- Fixing separate dustbins to collect solid waste generated in the form of food on a daily basis.
- Placing Waste bins at appropriate locations to maintain a clean and tidy campus.
- Providing guidance for the disposal of Paper and Cardboard
- Entering into a Memorandum of Understanding for e-Wastes.
- Organizing sensitization programmes on the conservation and use of water
- Organizing Awareness Programmes on environmental issues among staff/students/visitors and encouraging initiatives leading towards a clean environment.
- Enlightening students about Air, Water and Soil Pollution and its consequences
- Maintaining campus completely free from plastics and banning plastics.

- Morally teaching and encouraging staff and students to use bicycles and public transports/battery powered vehicles as a small initiative to control pollution
- Minimizing the consumption of water and enhancing ground water level by:
 - Encouraging to report leaks and rectifying them promptly
 - Progressively replacing / supplementing baths with shower facilities in hostels
 - Exploring options for using waste / roof water wherever possible
 - Establishing rain water harvesting schemes in all buildings of the campus
- Minimizing the consumption of electricity by:
 - Installing Solar Power Plant in the campus
 - Progressive replacement of light bulbs with LED bulbs.
 - Encouraging staff and residents to turn off electrical appliances when not in use
 - Conducting frequent preventive and corrective maintenance
- Adopting all health, safety and environment based codes of practice and relevant guidance and comply with legislation relating to the use of chemical products.
- Maintaining Green campus through adequate tree plantation by the college NSS Unit and the maintenance cell.
