An English Assessment Test conducted for Undergraduate Students afterthree weeks of their enrolment.

## **Syllabus for Bridge Course**

Foundation English Paper-1 focused purely on grammar and conversational practices. Topics covered are situational grammar, reading a sentence or passage with stress and intonations and an active listening by giving cloze test.

#### **Enrolment of Students**

For the academic year 2021-2022, **620** students had enrolled for the Course and **580** of them took part in the test. The classes were conducted from (18-07-2022) from the date of reopening for the odd Semester for Three weeks.

# **Conduct of Classes by Faculty Members**

Classes were conducted by the Faculty Members in the respective classes following the Odd Semester Time-Table.Since, the College reopened teaching of basic Grammar and sentence formation were part of the syllabus taught.

### **Conduct of Proficiency Level Test**

Bridge Test to diagnose the student's proficiency level in English Language. The Department has set the Assessment questionnaire which would help in identifying the areas to be trained which provide additional information to change the teaching strategy. 





At the end, the Organizing Secretary, Dr. S.U. Mohammed Riyaz, delivered a formal vote of thanks.




### WORKSHOP
