Report of National Level Seminar on "History of Millets"



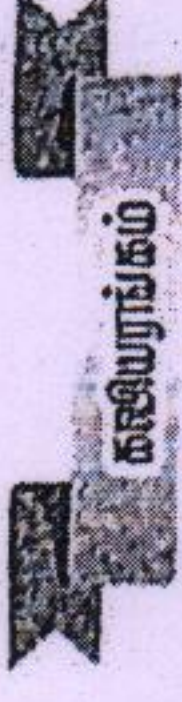

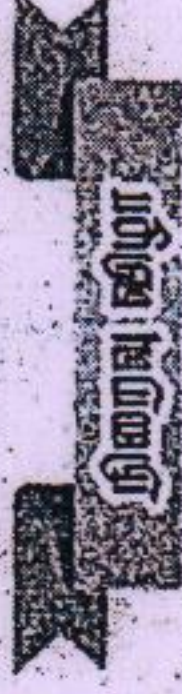

Report of A Skill development cum Research Oriented Programme on the Significance and scope of Archeology on 21st March 2023



Objectives

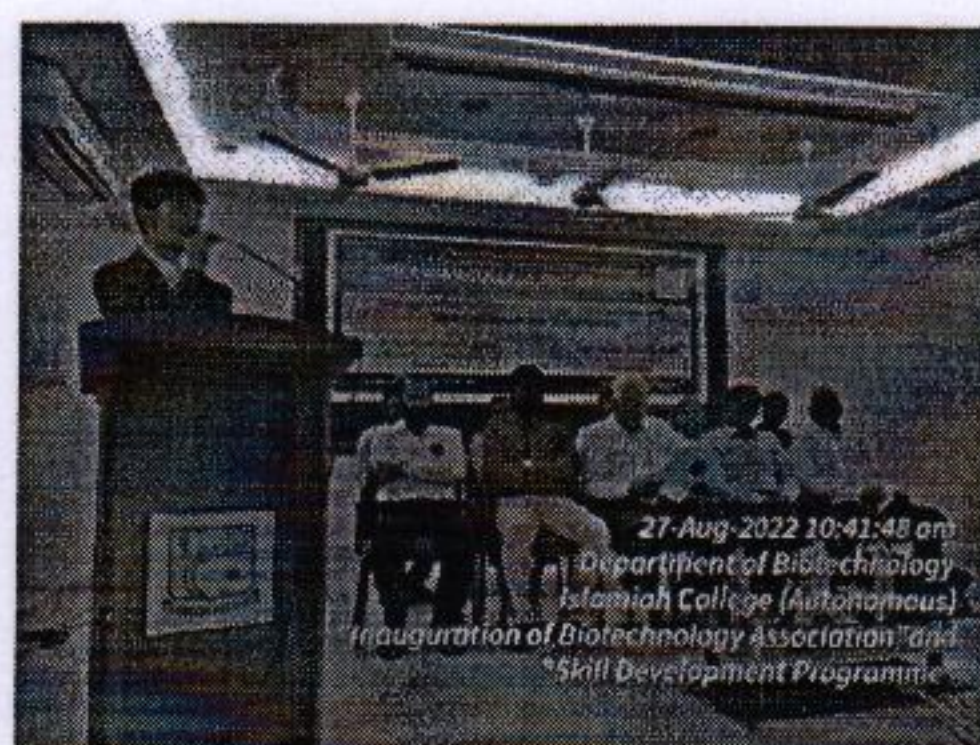
1. To facilitate the students' involvement in organizing functions.

Programme: Special Lecture

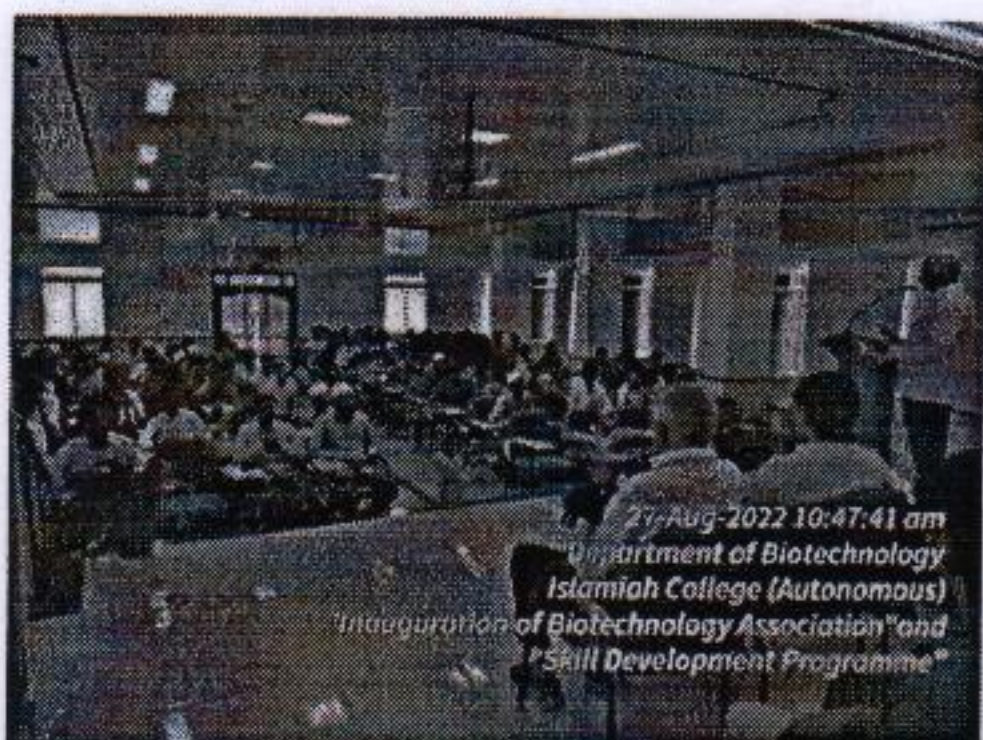
Title: "Biogenic Synthesis of Ag and Au nanoparticles and their applications in anticancer and food preservation"

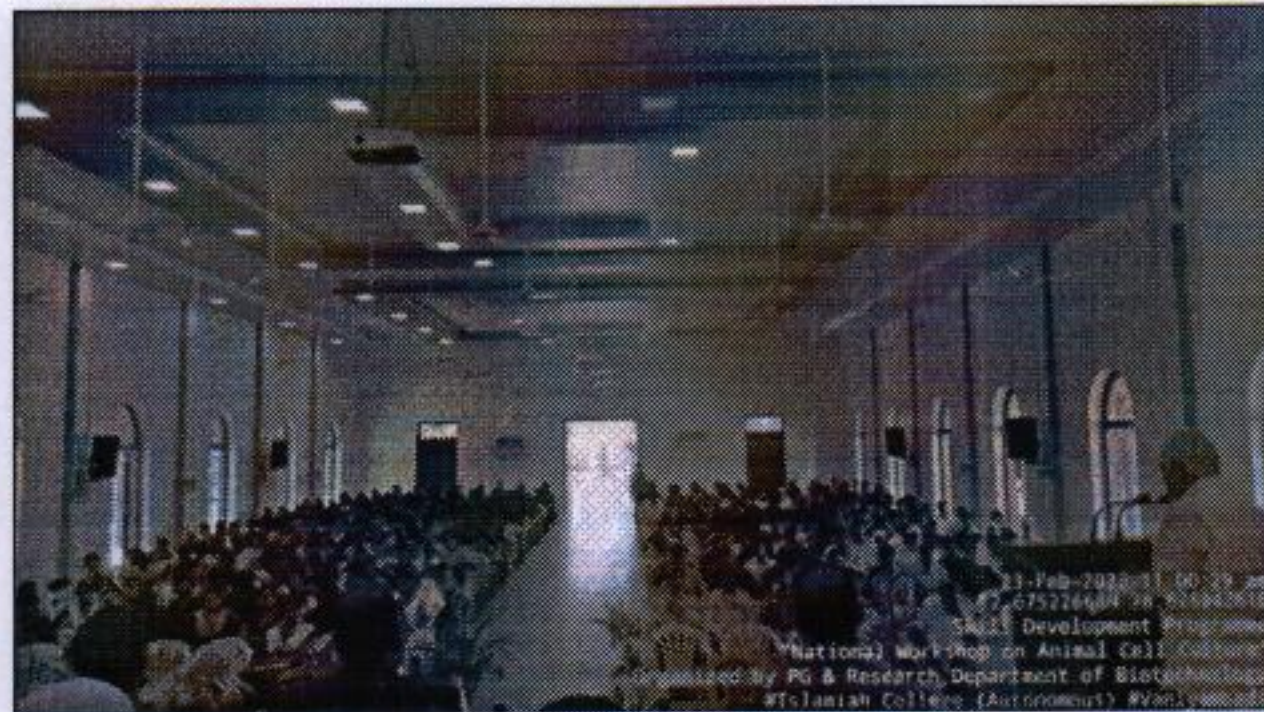
Objectives

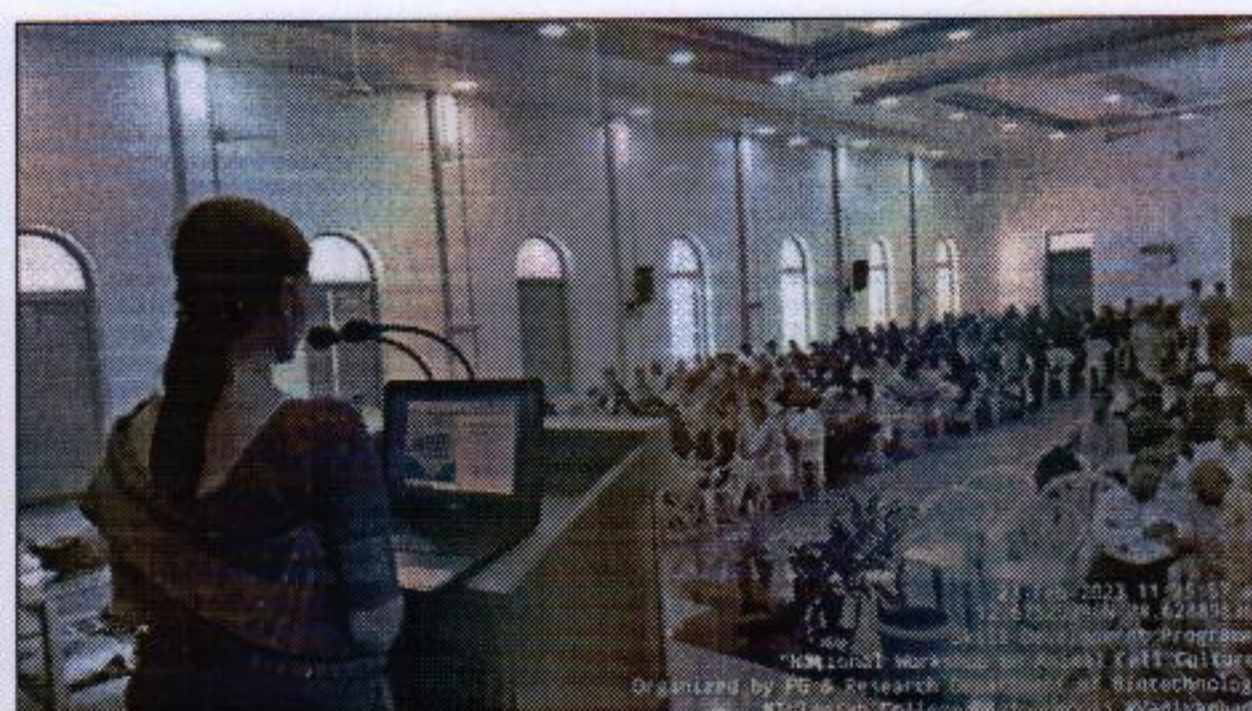
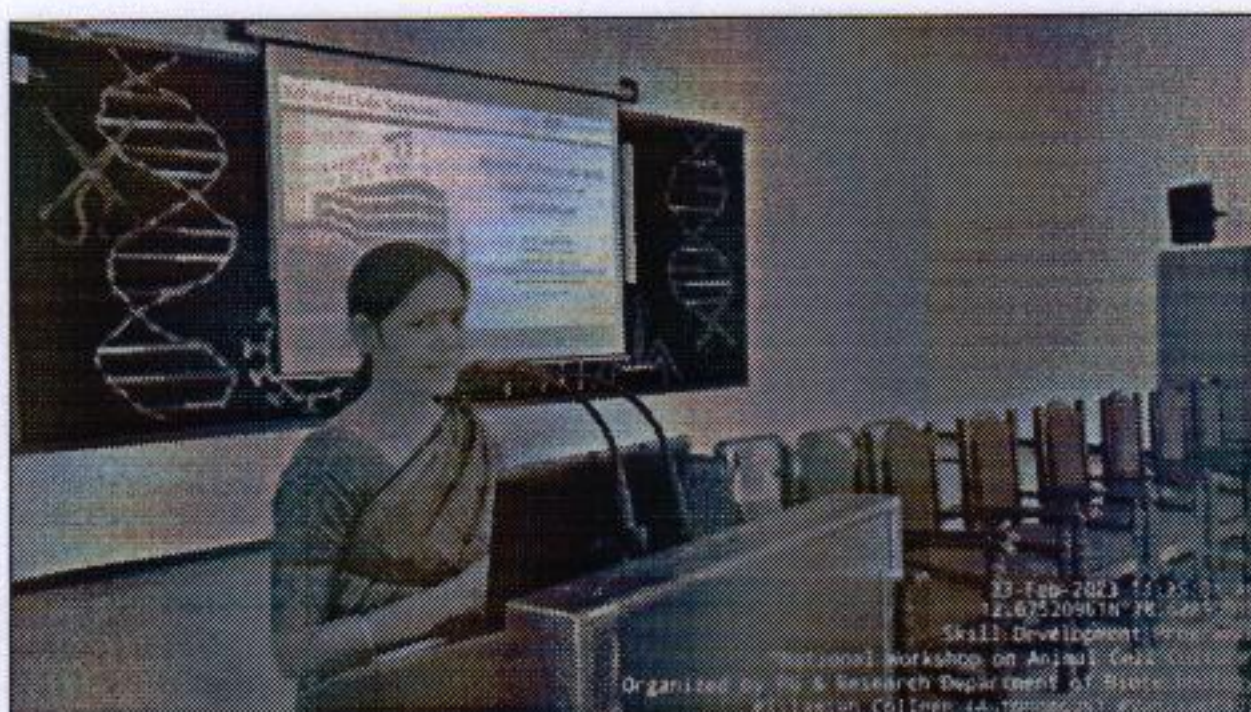

Special Lecture

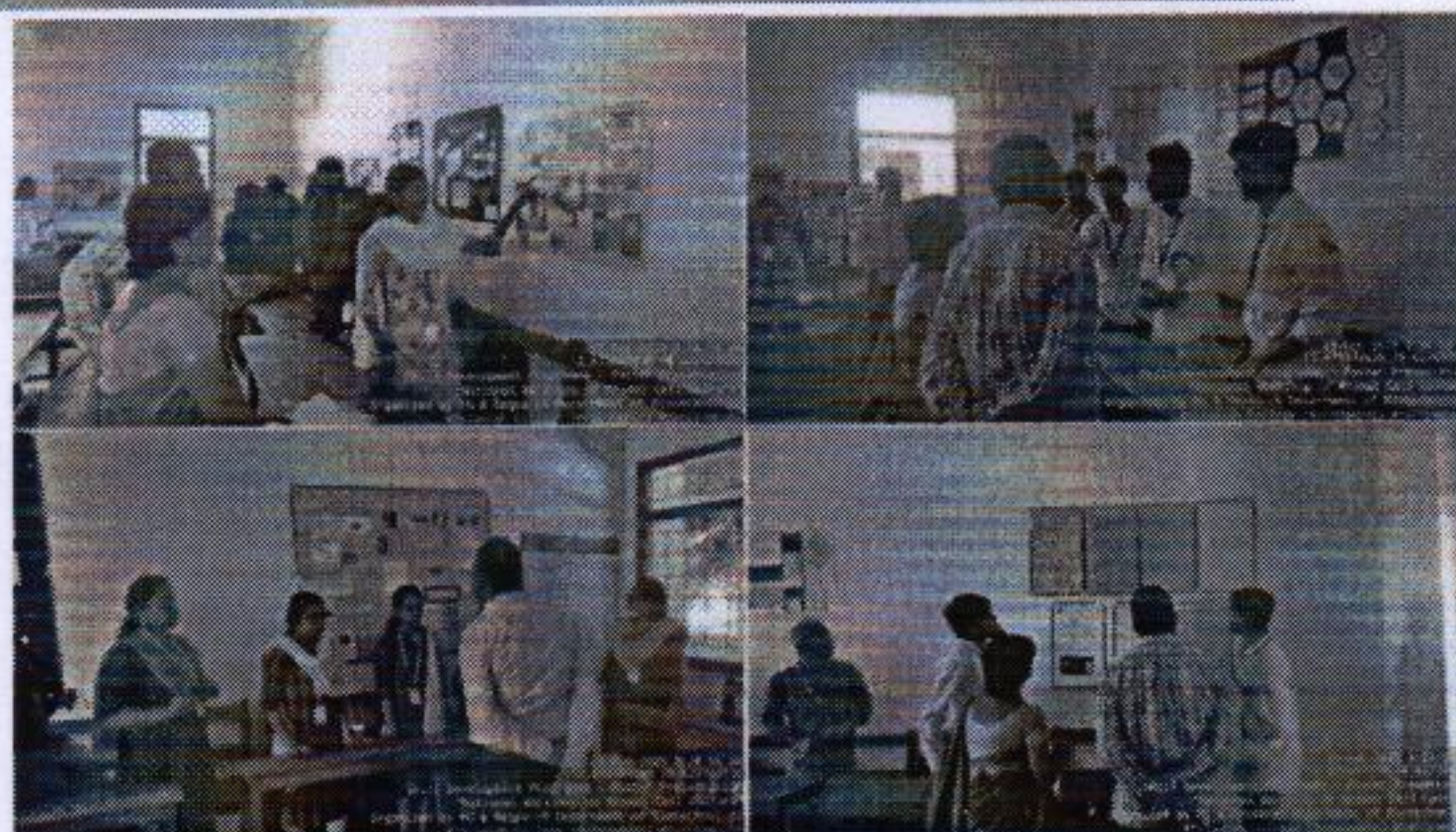

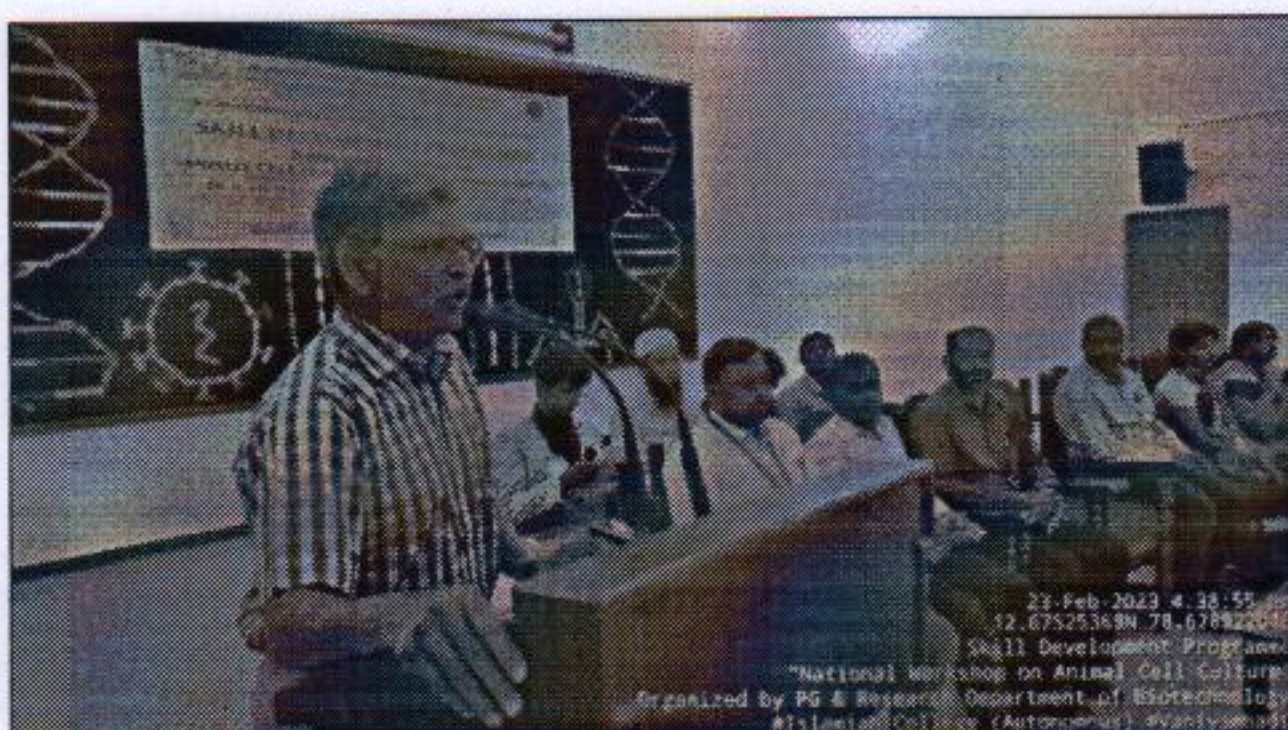
Poster presentation and E-Quiz

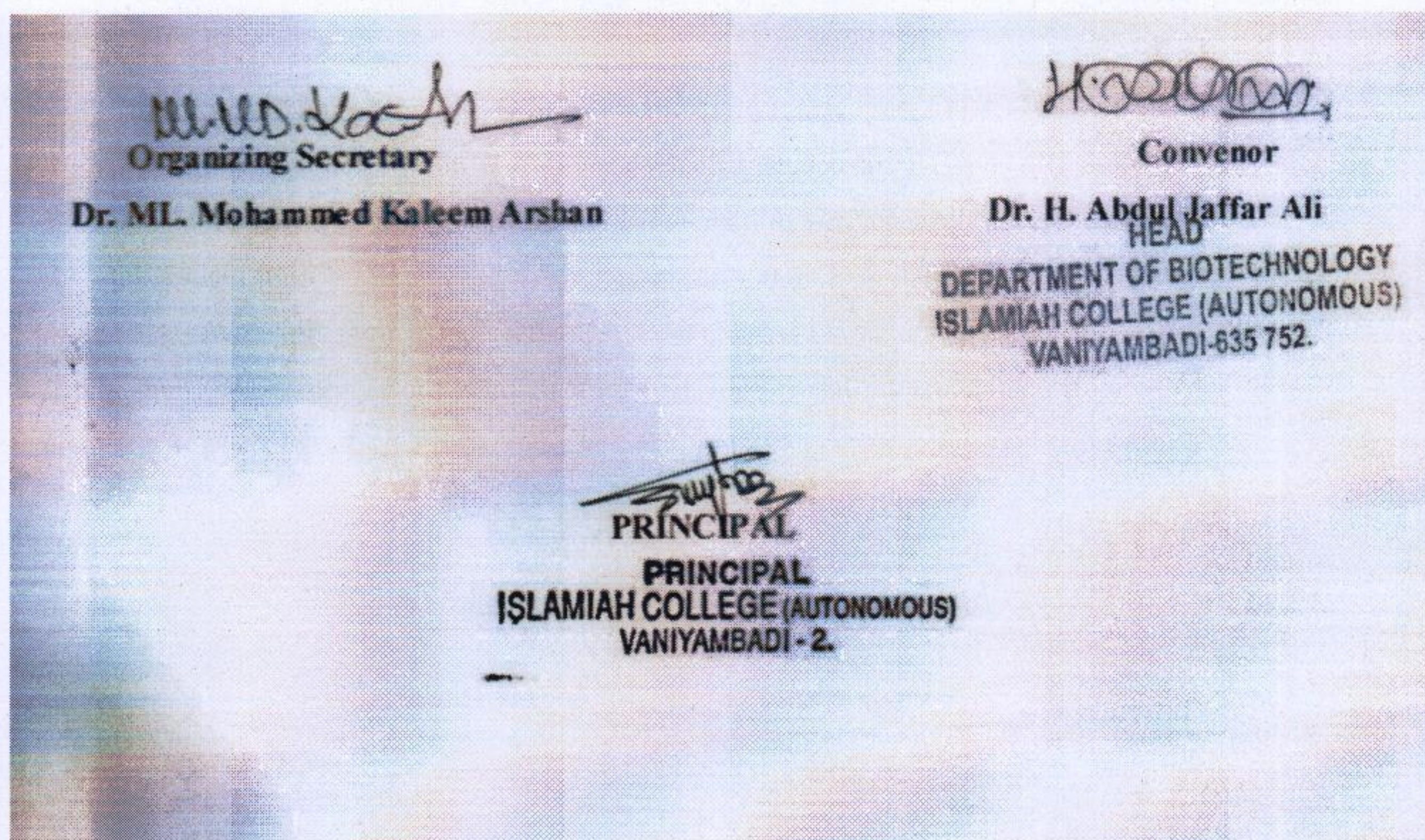

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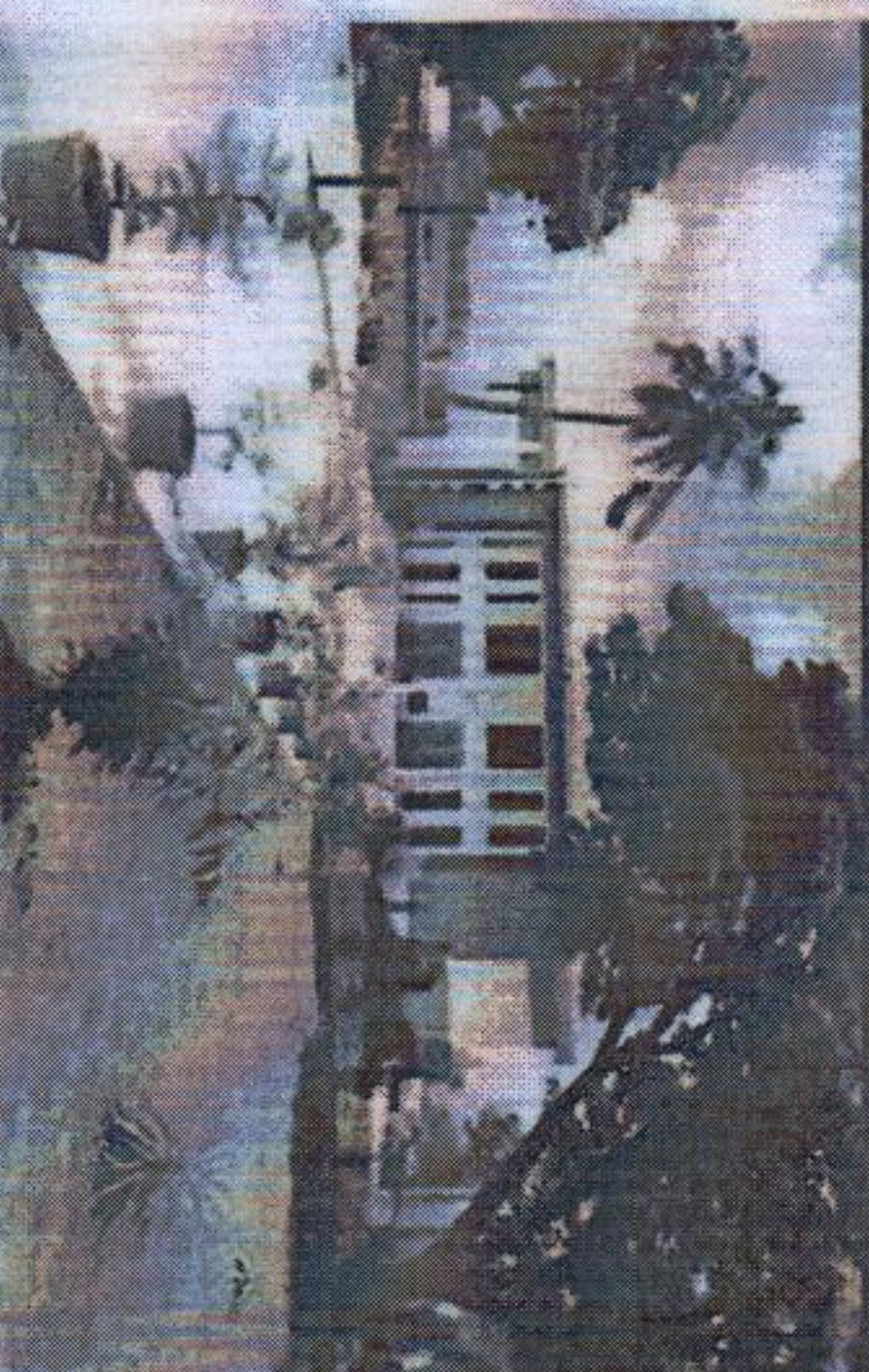

“GUT MICROBIOTA IN HEALTH AND DISEASE” ORGANIZED
BY THE DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY AT ALLAMA IQBAL
AUDITORIUM ON 11-08-2022 AT 10 A.M.**

The seminar began with the Quranic invocation by Mr. Ahsan Safeer .C of III B.Sc., Biochemistry. The Registration of the participants started at 9.30 a.m and the **inaugural Session** started at 10.30 a.m. **Dr. A. Liyakath Ali**, Head, Department of Biochemistry, welcomed the gathering. **Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas**, **Principal**, Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi delivered the presidential address. **Dr. H. Abdul Jaffar Ali**, **Head, Department of Biotechnology** Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi delivered the Felicitation address.

Dr. A. Liyakath Ali introduced the chief guest.

Technical Session began by 11 a.m. Dr. Anandh Babu Pon Velayutham (Alumnus of the Department 1987-1990 UG,) Associate Professor (Tenured) Department of Nutrition and Integrative Physiology, University of Utah, Salt Lake City, USA. Gave a lecture on **“Gut microbes metabolize dietary compounds and mediate vascular health”**

His talk focused on commensal bacteria and opportunistic bacteria and their role in health and disease. As such, the gut microbiota can exert profound influence on host metabolism by altering the composition of the bile acid pool, through altered bile acid synthesis and re-uptake. The gut microbiota has a regulatory function on host energy metabolism. By breaking down non digestible polysaccharides, gut microorganisms produce monosaccharides and short-chain fatty acids (SCFAs). Probiotics can sometimes help ease symptoms, including stomach pain, bloating, gas, diarrhea, and constipation. Probiotics are live microorganisms that've been isolated from human intestines and are shown to have beneficial effects when they're consumed in adequate amounts. Probiotics can be found in dietary supplements and fermented foods like kombucha, yogurt or tempeh. In order to be considered a probiotic, after ingestion, the microorganisms need to survive stomach acid and bile so they can make it all the way to your colon to meet up with the other live microorganisms living there. Once they arrive, they need to be able to survive in that environment. The more variety of these healthy microorganisms you have, the more they can do for you.

Prebiotics function as a food source for your gut's microorganisms and they need to bypass digestion and make it all the way to your colon. There, the microorganisms metabolize and ferment the prebiotics to survive. This metabolism and fermentation process is beneficial to your gut health because it creates a variety of other byproducts that help you in a number of ways.

When prebiotics are broken down by the microorganisms in your gut, different short-chain fatty acids are created depending on the kind of prebiotic. As a result, these short-chain fatty acids do a number of things like provide energy to your colon cells, help with mucus production and aid in inflammation and immunity.

The alumnus also shared about his nostalgic memories of his college days and motivated the students to go for higher studies and research. The students felt happy and they want us to conduct more programmes like this.

Dr. A. Gokulakrishnan presented the report on the seminar and Dr. M.P. Ashar Waheed proposed the vote of thanks. The programme came to an end with National Anthem. The feedback from the participants was received through Google form and on submission they downloaded their participation certificate.

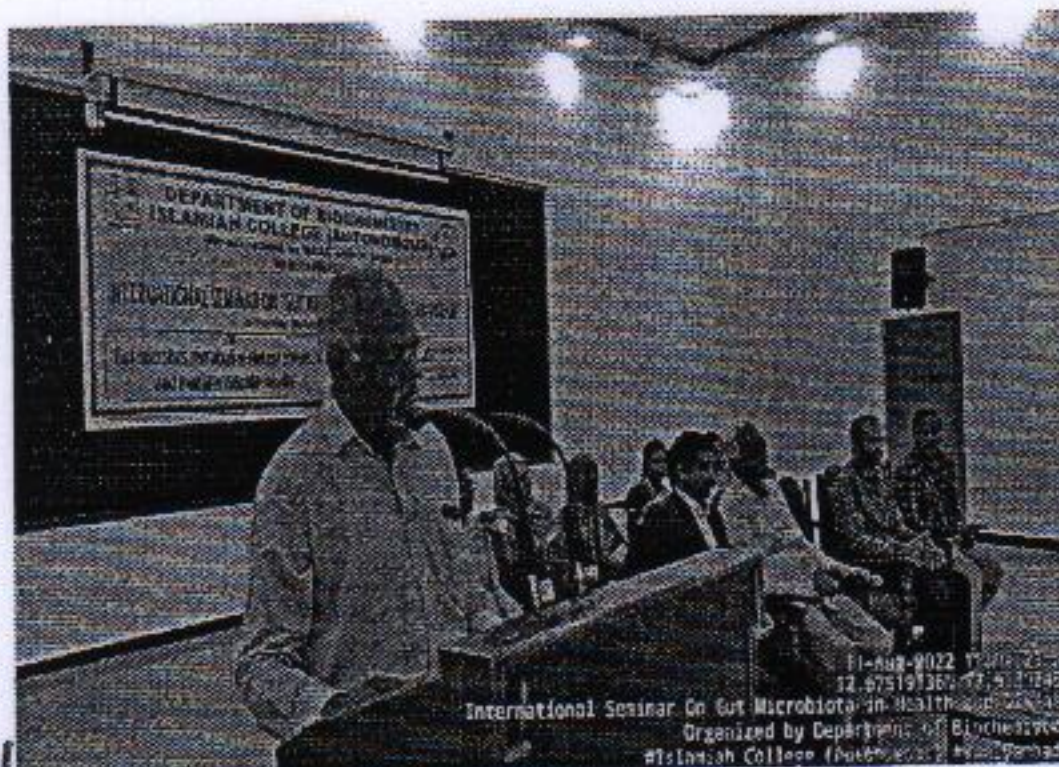
