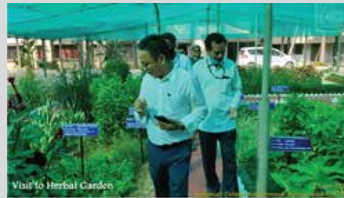

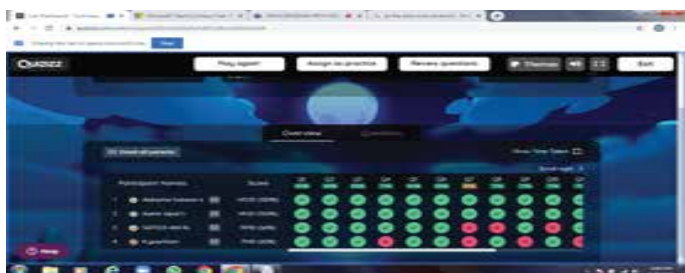
STATE LEVEL WORKSHOP | CHEMISTRY

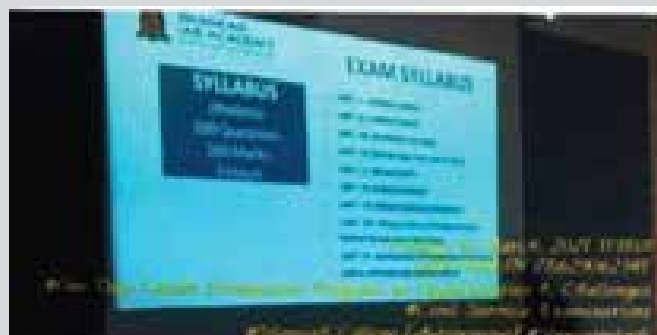


CAREER GUIDANCE & PLACEMENT CELL

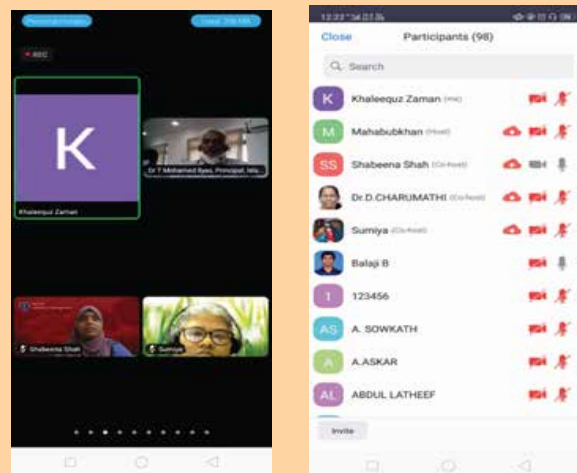
Blood Donation Camp

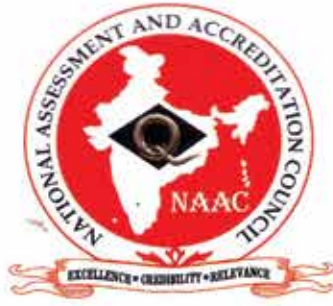
