
#### Day-I (01-04-2022) - KEELADI





We departed from Tanjore after lunch and reached Kallanai at Truchrappalli by evening.








The seminar began with the Quranic invocation by Moolay Mohammed Adnan of II M.Sc., Biochemistry. The Registration of the participants started at 9.30 a.m and the inaugural Session started at 10.00 a.m. Dr. A. Liyakath Ali, Head, Department of Biochemistry, welcomed the gathering.

Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, Principal, Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi delivered the presidential address.

Dr. A. Liyakath Ali introduced the chief guests.

Technical Session began by 11 am, Dr. Irfan A. Asangani, (Alumnus of the Department 1996-1999 UG, 1999-2001 PG) Assistant Professor, Department of Cancer Biology, Perelman School of Medicine, University of Pennsylvania, USA, gave a lecture on "Sex Hormones signal why COVID-19 hits men harder." His talk focused on targeting androgen receptor which is responsible for the expression of ACE2 receptor TMPR SS2 receptor where the spike protein of COVID -19 virus binds. Since men are more susceptible compared to women, this strategy would help men overcoming severity of COVID-19. He discussed on the strategies he employed in the discovery of the drug and he disclosed that the new drug is under phase III clinical trial. He also provided career guidance regarding the opportunities in biochemistry in India and abroad.

After break the next Technical Session started by Dr. M.L Arbab Sikander (Alumnus of the Department 1996-1999 UG, 1999-2001 PG), Former Assistant Professor, Department of Biochemistry (MLT), College of Applied Medical Sciences, Jazan University, Jazan, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, gave a lecture on "Genetic Polymorphisms in Irritable Bowel Syndrome and Ulcerative Colitis." He talked about the irritable bowel syndrome and inflammatory bowel



disease. He also emphasized on serotonin transporter gene, alpha 2A adrenergic receptor polymorphism in irritable bowel syndrome and ulcerative colitis.







Excavators from UoM suggest existence of 'continuous human activities'

VELLORE: Several antiquities, including potsherds, stone and iron tools and burnished wares, found at a Vellore excavation site by a team of excavators belonging to University of Madras suggest existence of 'continuous human activities' from Neolithic period to early historic period in the region.

A team of twenty six second-year postgraduate students of department of ancient history and archaeology of the university began the expedition, continuation of the previous year's excavation, at Chenthurmalai in Valasai village near Gudiyatham, on 8 February.

The team was led by head of department (in-charge) of ancient history and archaeology Dr J Soundararajan and Jinu Koshi, site director. "The current expedition is an extension of the excavation the team had made last year yielding discovery of an ash mound,"





Soundararajan said. He added, "Three trenches were dug up this time yielding a collection of post sherds, bones, broken polished axes, flakes and cores beneath the ashy layer." The bones found at the site are jaw with teeth of cattle and jaw of dog species. Neolithic material remains like burnished grey ware, red ware, black ware, grinding stones in broken and complete conditions were also discovered by the team.


The stone tools bear testimony to the use of tools in the region during Neolithic age. "Russel coated painted ware, black and red ware, red slipped ware and burnished ware have been found from one of the trenches, according to Soundararajan. Another significant finding of the excavation team is evidences of 'fire activities' and 'iron smelting'. He explained, "Iron age and early historic age potteries were collected. Evidences of iron smelting activities in the form of furnace, tuyeres and slags were also seen at the site."

The excavation site Valasai is surrounded by KV Kuppam and Anicut blocks, both falling under Vellore district, and Bangarupalem and Yadamari blocks of neighbouring Andhra Pradesh. The ash mound found in the village is 'reasonable, plausible and conforming' the 'pattern' and 'life-style' of the neolithic cultural sequences with iron technology, the excavators noted.

They stated that the iron implements were required for digging, ploughing, harvesting and other activities. Thus, the ash mound, iron presence and other ceramic ware prove the inter-related high temperature handling of ceramic and metallurgical skills of the people settled here.



An English Assessment Test conducted for Undergraduate Students afterthree weeks of their enrolment.

#### Syllabus for Bridge Course

Foundation English Paper-1 focused purely on grammar and conversational practices. Topics covered are situational grammar, reading a sentence or passage with stress and intonations and an active listening by giving cloze test.

#### **Enrolment of Students**

For the academic year 2018-2019, 700 students enrolled for the Course and 550 of them took part in the test. The classes were conducted after reopening for odd Semester from day one for Three weeks.

#### Conduct of Classes by Faculty Members

Classes were conducted by the Faculty Members in the respective classes following the Odd Semester Time-Table.Since, the College reopened teaching of basic Grammar and sentence formation were part of the syllabus taught.

#### **Conduct of Proficiency Level Test**


