Instantly Janab L. M. Muneer Ahmed, Secretary and Correspondent, Islamiah College (Autonomous) happily consented to start the preparations for the organization of the programme. An organization committee was constituted immediately with D. Abul Fazal as the Programme Coordinator and other staff members of the Department namely Dr. C. Mohamed Faheem, Mr. M. Siddique Ahmed, Dr. K. Murugan, Mr. P. Basith Assarani, Dr. Mohammad Osman Pasha, Mr. G. Harigaran and Mr. R. Mohammad Ghufuran to successfully manage the organization of the programme effectively.

The basic need of the programme was to acquaint interested college students with the necessity of the rights of Marginalised sections and also be informed about measures of the government to empower such sections.

Sixty interested Students from different academic disciplines were selected to attend the programme through a circular. Few students were from an urban background and many were from a rural background. Most of the students were from socially and economically underprivileged sections

The Basic objectives of the Training programme were (a) To sensitize the students about the Need for Basic Human Rights (b) To inform the students on the Rights guaranteed in Universal Declarations and International Charters (c) To update the students about the rights granted by the Indian Constitution (d) To apprise the students about the contemporary issues concerning Human Rights (e) To discuss about the remedial measures for the challenges concerning Human Rights (f) To ensure the students are acquainted with the welfare schemes of the Government to uplift the downtrodden and under – privileged sections.

The Three - Day Training programme began on 14 March 2022 at 9. 00 a.m. with an inaugural speech by Dr. Major Syed Shahabuddeen highlighting the necessity and importance of such Training Programmes.


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On 14.03.2022 in the forenoon in Session I Dr. G. Palanidurai, Retired Professor Gandhi Gram University, addressed the students about the Challenges and Opportunities in Educating Rural Masses on Human Rights. In this session the necessity of Human Rights and methodologies to be adopted to educate rural people were discussed. The students carried the message that Human Rights Education begins with the self.



On 14.03.2022 in the forenoon in Session II Dr. K. Mohanasundaram spoke to the participants on Indian Constitution and Fundamental Rights where the participants were

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informed about all the Fundamental Rights enshrined in the Indian Constitution and their importance and significance.



On 14.03.2022 in the afternoon in Session III Dr. A. Anji, Teaching Faculty of Karnatak University informed the students about the Constitutional provisions and other Legal provisions guaranteeing Gender Justice. In Session IV Dr. A. Anji highlighted about the government schemes and policies empowering Indian women.

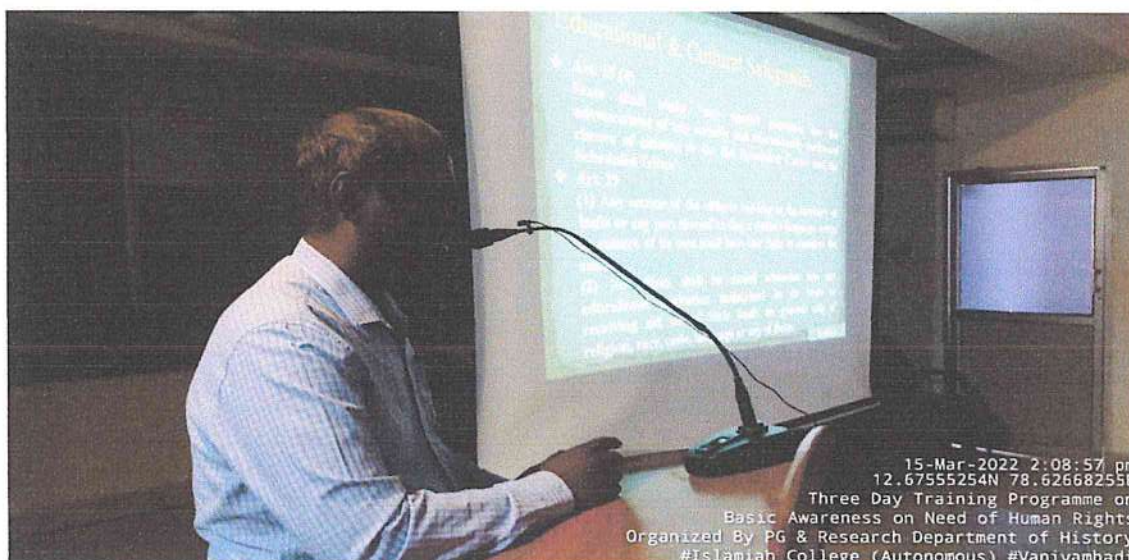

XIIth session the Mr. R. Mohamad Hasan had informed the students about the Schemes and Policies of the government to empower the Dalit community.

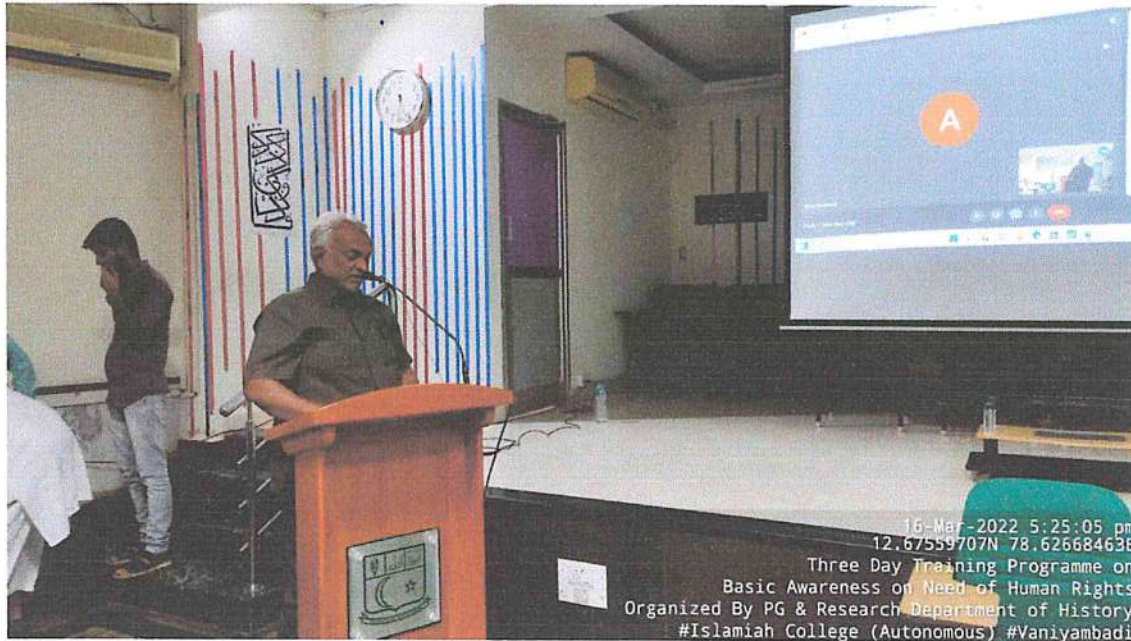

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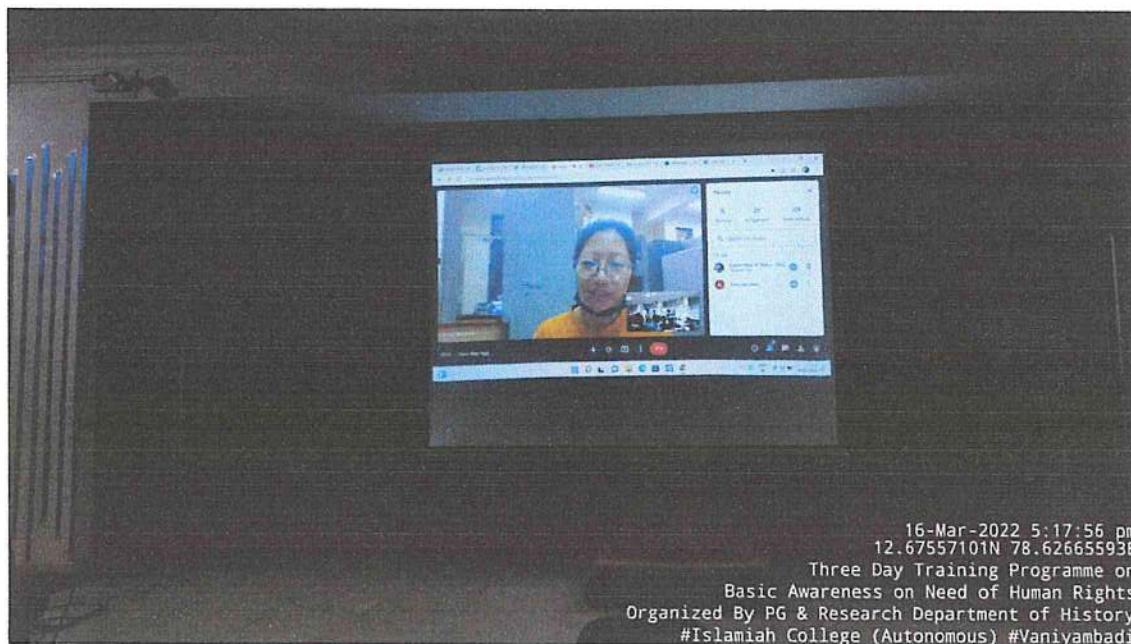

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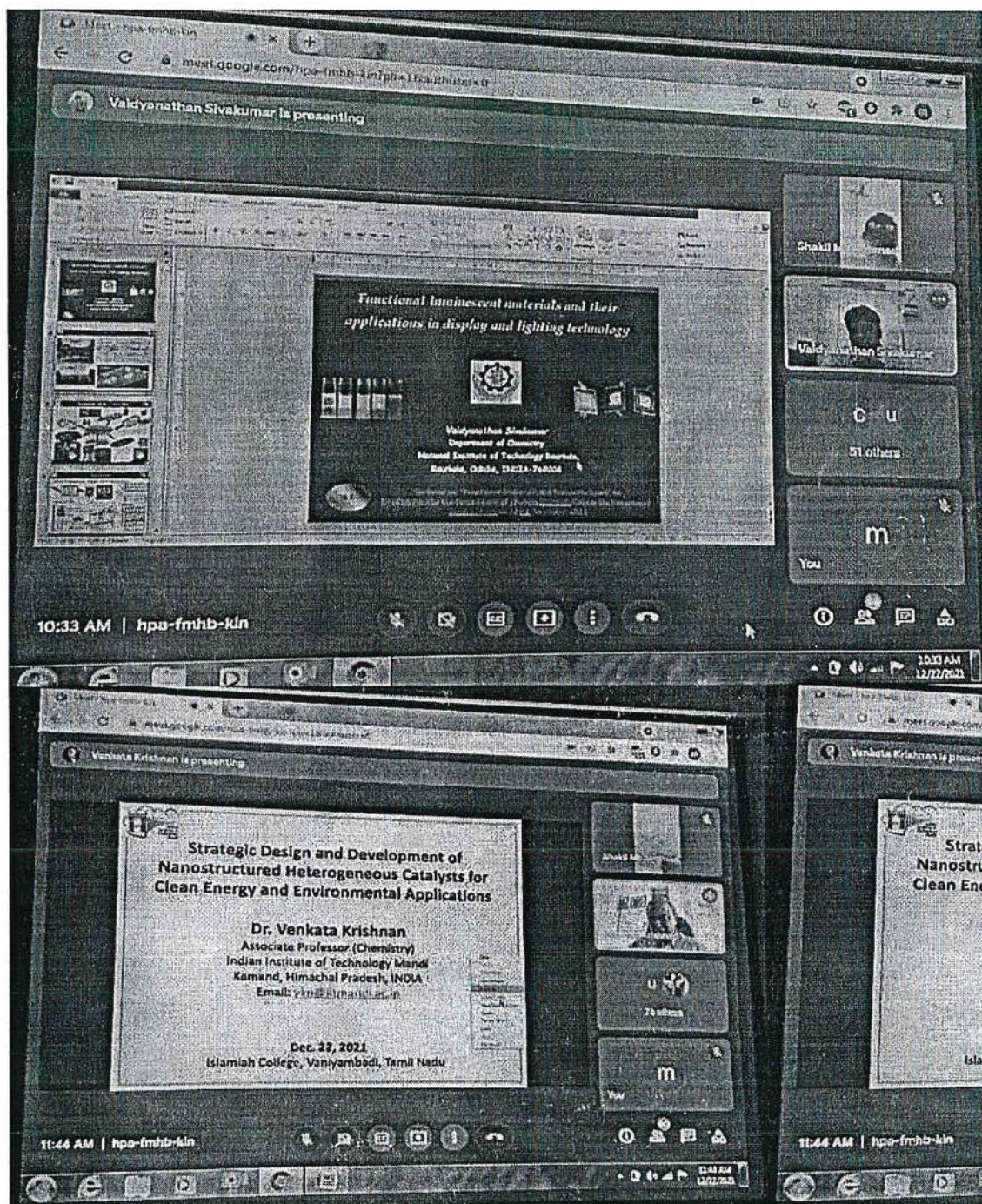


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National webinar-22.12.2021

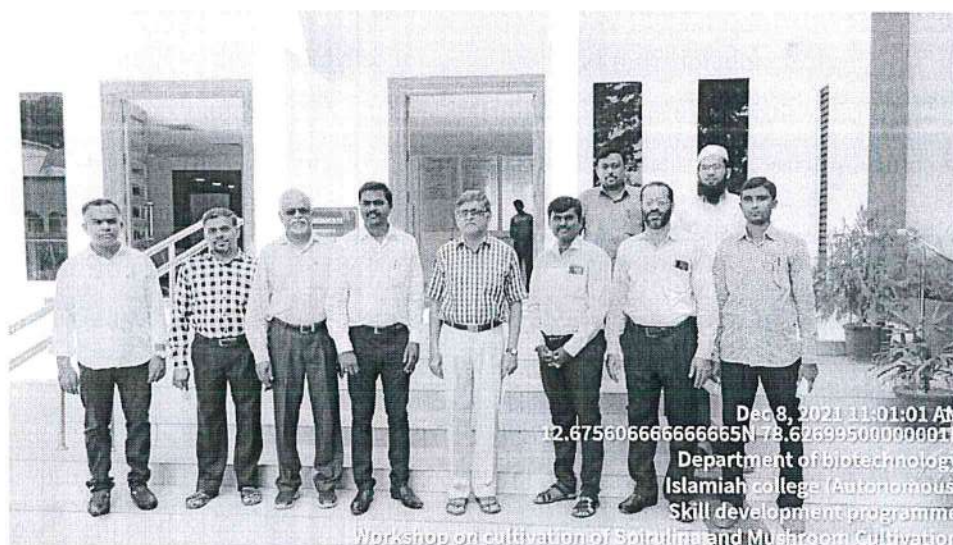
Objectives

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Technical session I

Chief Guest Dr.S.Babu delivered a lecture on "Algal technology and its value added bioproducts" using power point slides.

He motivated and impressed the students by his nice presentation covering introduction to algae, functions of spirulina, spirulina culture and production, methods of culture, global and national scenario in spirulina culture and culture practices, harvest & post-harvest technology, product quality, value added products, productivity of spirulina, and economics of spirulina culture.

Followed by this, in interaction session, students actively interacted with chief guest and questions and doubts raised by the students were cleared by the chief guest in a interactive way.

Technical session II.

The next speaker Dr. R. Govindaraj, Managing Director, Sri Marutham AgroBiotech, Madurai presented his power point slides on **"Be on Entrepreneur by cultivating Mushrooms at Home"**. He started his speech by giving an introduction on Mushroom by explaining mushroom is a type of fungi and the cultivation was started in 17th century in France. He mentioned his speech by saying the health benefits of Mushroom and the scope of mushroom cultivation in Tamilnadu.

He explained by mentioning the market scenario in Tamilnadu and that 90% mushroom are imported and 10% are made up locally cultivated mushroom. He explained the oyster mushroom cultivation in an elaborate way He enlightened the students about the advantages of oyster mushroom He continued his speech by explaining the production cost for starting the cultivation of each batch of mushroom.

In his presentation, he also enlightened on how to identify poisonous mushroom and introduction on the toxin known as mycotoxin and amanitin.

He covered the other topics such as health benefits of mushroom, regular consumption of mushrooms or the consumption of isolated bioactive constituents and different medicinal properties of mushroom.

Followed by his presentation, the participants were given training to pack the mushroom bags in the Biotechnology Lab.

He demonstrated the method of mushroom cultivation with the students as follows:

1. Autoclaving of 10 kg of paddy straw for preparing layer.
3. Cleaning of floors and working area with soap solution.
4. Precautions to be taken while purchasing Oyster Mushroom Spawn.
5. Materials to be purchased and kept ready (Paddy straw 10 kg, spawn, tray, rubber bands, Polypropylene bags 12"x 24" inch, cleaning solutions etc).

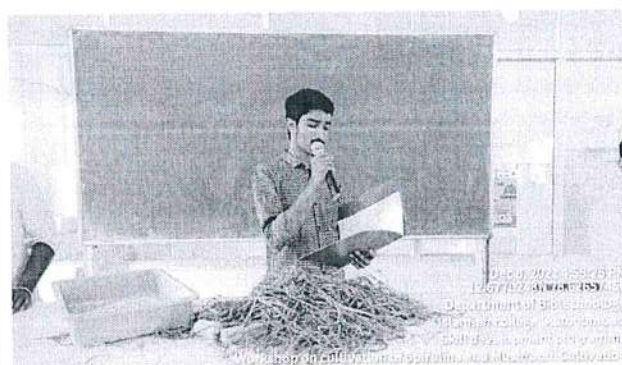

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Report on National Seminar on “Molecular Basis of Cancer & Liver Diseases” ORGANIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF BIOCHEMISTRY AT ALLAMA IQBAL AUDITORIUM ON 24-12-2021 AT 10 A.M.

The seminar began with the Quranic invocation by Moolay Mohammed Adnan of II M.Sc., Biochemistry. The Registration of the participants started at 9.30 a.m and the **inaugural Session** started at 10.00 a.m. **Dr. A. Liyakath Ali**, Head, Department of Biochemistry, welcomed the gathering.

Dr. S. Raja Mohamed Kamil, Vice-Principal, Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi delivered the presidential address and Dr. H. Abdul Jaffar Ali, Head, Department of Biotechnology, felicitated on the occasion.

Dr. A. Gokulakrishnan, Assistant professor of Biochemistry introduced the resource person Dr. P Ashok Kumar, Associate professor, School of Life sciences, B. S. Abdur Rahman Crescent Institute of science & technology, Chennai.

The seminar began with the Quranic invocation by Moolay Mohammed Adnan of II M.Sc., Biochemistry. The Registration of the participants started at 9.30 a.m and the **inaugural Session** started at 10.00 a.m. **Dr. A. Liyakath Ali**, Head, Department of Biochemistry, welcomed the gathering.

Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, Principal, Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi delivered the presidential address.

Dr. A. Liyakath Ali introduced the chief guests.

Technical Session began by 11 am, Dr. Irfan A. Asangani, (Alumnus of the Department 1996-1999 UG, 1999-2001 PG) Assistant Professor, Department of Cancer Biology, Perelman School of Medicine, University of Pennsylvania, USA, gave a lecture on "**Sex Hormones signal why COVID-19 hits men harder.**" His talk focused on targeting androgen receptor which is responsible for the expression of ACE2 receptor TMPRSS2 receptor where the spike protein of COVID -19 virus binds. Since men are more susceptible compared to women, this strategy would help men overcoming severity of COVID-19. He discussed on the strategies he employed in the discovery of the drug and he disclosed that the new drug is under phase III clinical trial. He also provided career guidance regarding the opportunities in biochemistry in India and abroad.

After break the next Technical Session started by **Dr. M.L Arbab Sikander** (Alumnus of the Department 1996-1999 UG, 1999-2001 PG), Former Assistant Professor, Department of Biochemistry (MLT), College of Applied Medical Sciences, Jazan University, Jazan, Kingdom of Saudi Arabia, gave a lecture on "**Genetic Polymorphisms in Irritable Bowel Syndrome and Ulcerative Colitis.**" He talked about the irritable bowel syndrome and inflammatory bowel

The feedback from the participants was received and they felt happy and they want us to conduct more programmes like this.



The workshop was well received by the students and benefitted them.



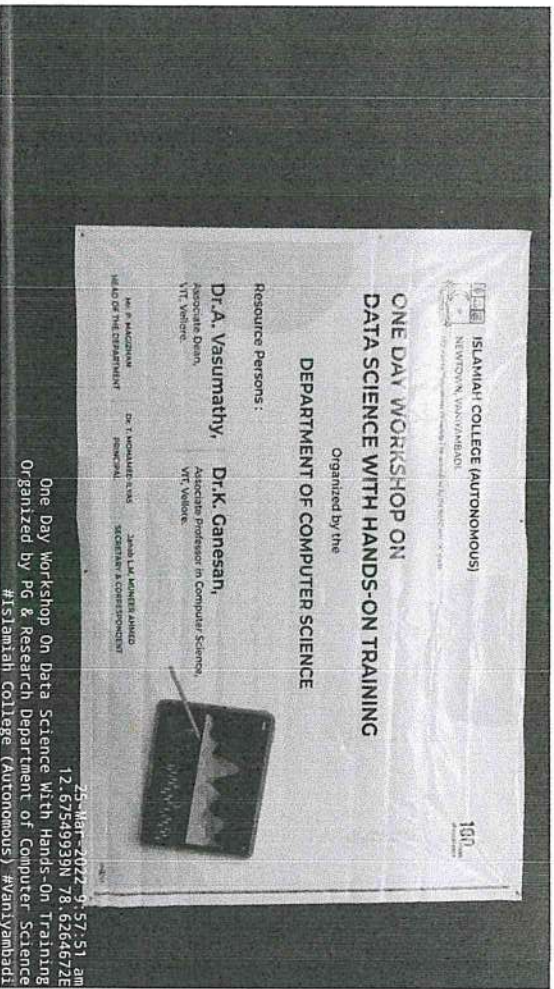
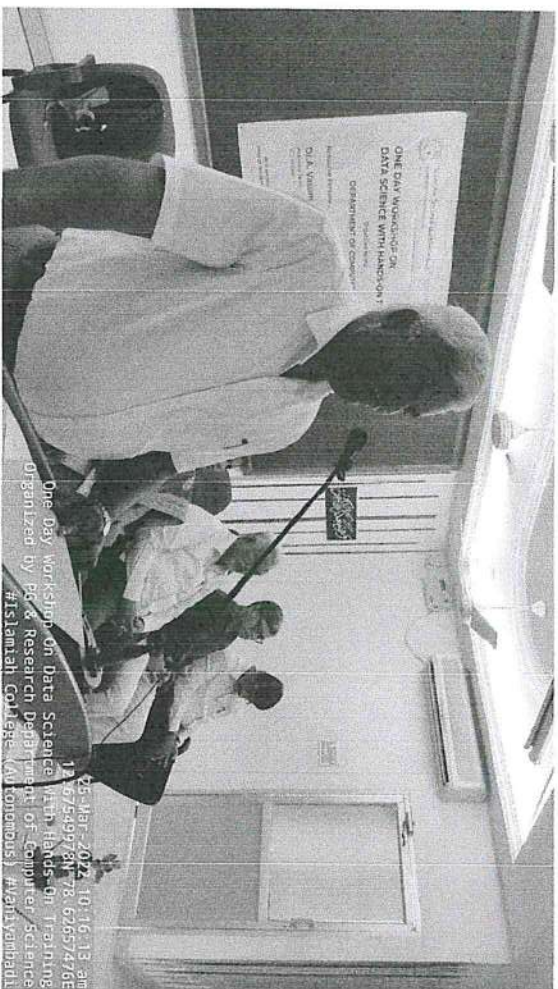
