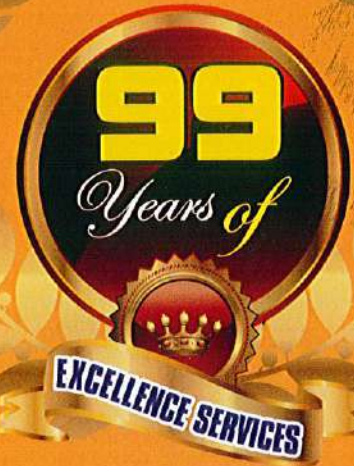

International Journal of Science and Humanities (IJS), Volume 3, Issue 1 & 2, (2017) of our College has been brought out during the month of January 2018.

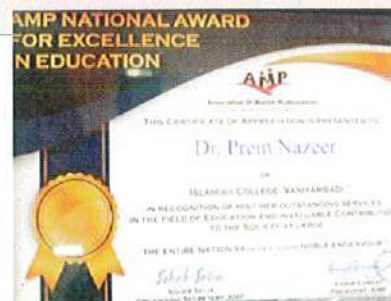
Scheme of Project on Science :

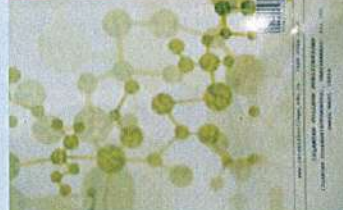

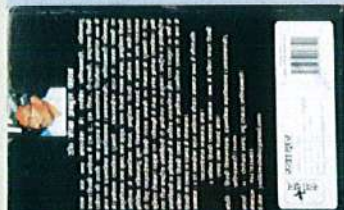

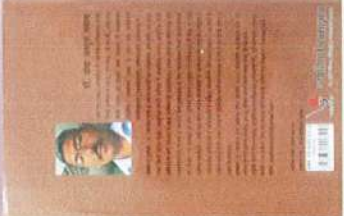
