ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

Islamiyah College (Autonomous) was established in 1919 by the Vaniyambadi Muslim Educational Society and was first affiliated to University of Madras, Chennai and now to Thiruvalluvar University, Serkadu, Vellore. The college was conferred with Autonomy from the academic year 2010 – 2011 and reaccredited by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC), Bangalore with "A" grade from February 2014. At present it offers 12 UG courses, 9 PG courses, 8 M. Phil Courses and 6 Ph.D. courses in various disciplines of Arts, Science and Commerce. The college keeps its portals open to the members of all castes and communities. It provides a quality of education to all sections of people. Though it was founded as a minority institution, it lends it helping hand to students of those belonging to other religions.

ABOUT THE DEPARTMENT

The department of Economics one of the founding department of the college. In 1946 college was upgraded to a first grade degree college offering instruction in the two years degree course in B.A. (Economics) According to the new educational setup in 1956, the University of Madras granted permission for opening Pre University course and three years B.A. Economics course. During the year 1977 & 1978 department of Economics was converted into department of Public Relations due to its more employability. Again in 1980 – 81 due to the poor response of the student's admission in the department of public relation, it was reconverted into department of Economics. In the year 2010-11 due to the need of changing scenario of the society and employability the department of Economics has been converted into department of Commerce (Finance & Accounts) as specialization. The department organized two – day State Level Seminar on "Economic Democracy in Tamil Nadu" in the year 2000-01 sponsored by UGC, New Delhi and again the two day National Level Seminar on "Impact of Minority Educational Institutions in the Empowerment of Deprived Classes" in the year 2014 sponsored by UGC, New Delhi. The department offers Ph.D. Part time program in Economics so far, 4 awarded and one waiting for viva – voce examination

About the Concept:

The growth of Islamic banking and finance as a new discipline, and become one of the fastest growing segments of the financial market industry operating through more than three hundred institutions in 75 countries. Economist view financial and legal system are two prominent mechanisms through which economic growth either be supported or suppressed, certain components of interest free banking and financing such as risk sharing, stability and innovation are proven stimulants of growth while others including limited liquidity may be detrimental to the economy.

Islamic banks try to fulfill economic needs of Muslim population by providing products that are compliant with Shariah law. Such products are constructed around the philosophy that no person should profit from another's laws, thereby prohibiting Riba (interest) the entitlement of return from assets must lie one bearing the risk involved in creating the return. Riba considered to be a greater sin for Muslims than eating pork, drinking alcohol.

Islamic Banks share in the risk of equity participation contracts a credit default swaps are forbidden. Profit sharing acts as an incomplete risk transfer in Islamic banks since the bank bears the entire burden of financial risk while the entrepreneur is solely responsible for the risk of wasted time and effort. If a borrower's profit is unsuccessful the bank alone takes loss of profits and the borrower is no longer obligated to pay back the loan. So the banks are highly selective in their loan processes and very strict in monitoring of projects thereafter. Further Islamic banks do not allow investment in toxic assets derivatives, conventional institutions etc. Since these investments are considered to be inappropriate gambling and generating revenue by speculation on the movement of money, also forbidden in Islamic law. As a result the Islamic banks have higher capital adequacy ratio, higher capital to assets ratios, smaller investment portfolios and low whole sale deposits.



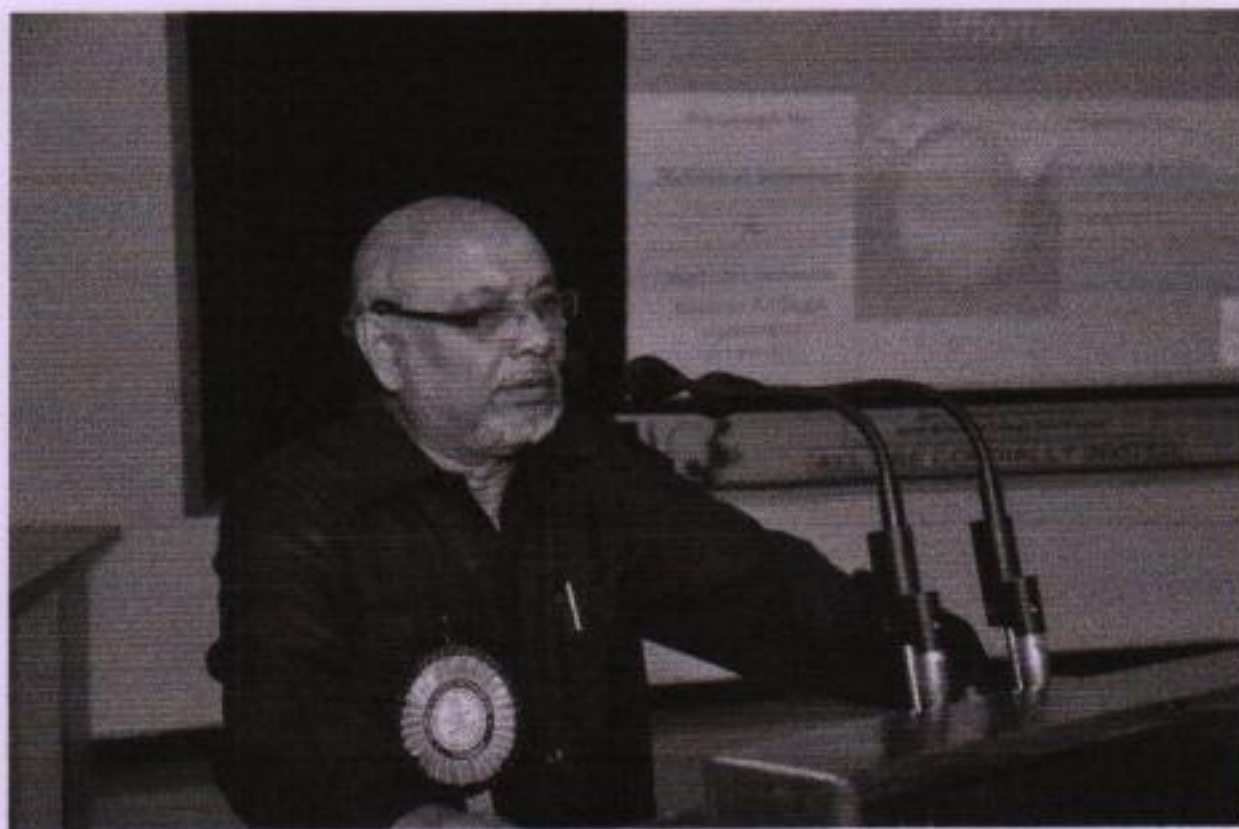



A REPORT

Background

It has been estimated that 10 -100 million species of organisms exist on the Earth but it is pitiable to note that only 1.7 million species have been systematically studied and documented in world records. Presently the biodiversity crisis is accompanied by dwindling number of taxonomists throughout the scientists' community resulting in the neglect of many highly diverse group of organisms. These bottlenecks have severely limited our understanding of biodiversity and signal the need for a new approach to taxon recognition. In changing regime of time, the traditional taxonomy has lagged behind considerably. In this scenario, DNA barcoding is emerged as a powerful tool to unify taxonomy, globally. Unfortunately, in India considerable efforts have not been paved the way for popularization of DNA barcoding.

Therefore, Islamiah College undertook the planning for a DNA Barcoding workshop scheduled for the beginning of 2019 to provide information on the most recent advancements on the method and to allow potential users of DNA barcoding to be trained on tools for data analysis that can critically influence the outcomes of DNA barcoding for species identification.

The Department of Biotechnology organised this programmed in collaboration with the Xetra Biosolution, Coimbatore.
