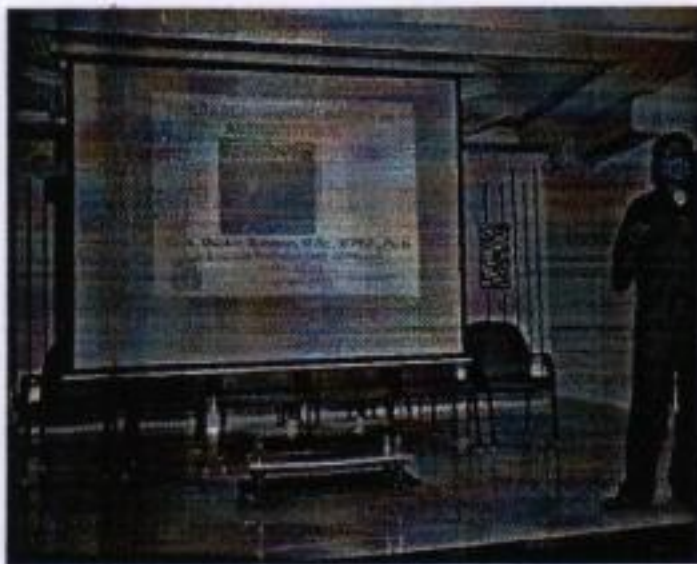
“Special lecture on Astrophysics”



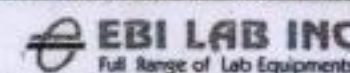


Objectives of the Seminar:

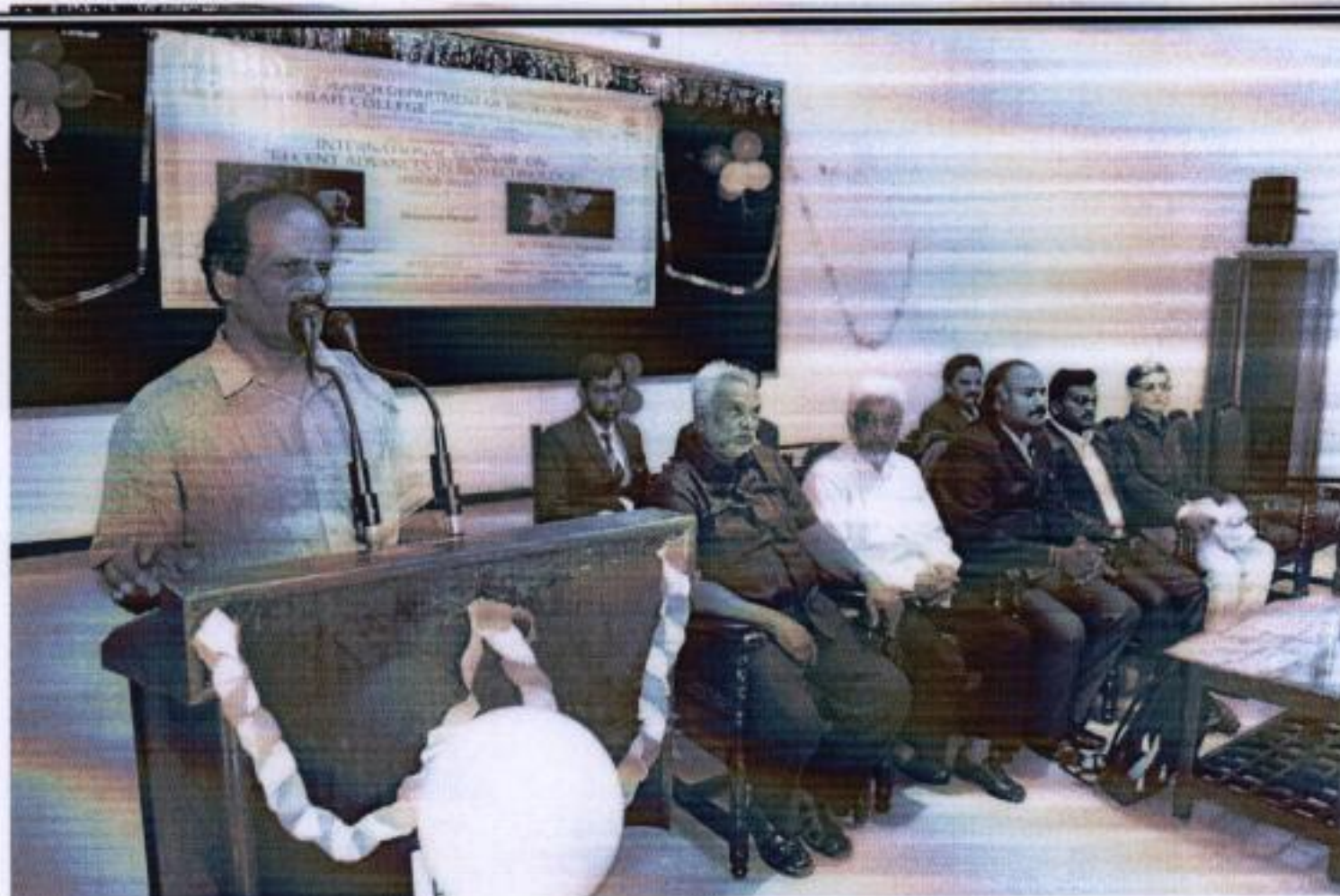

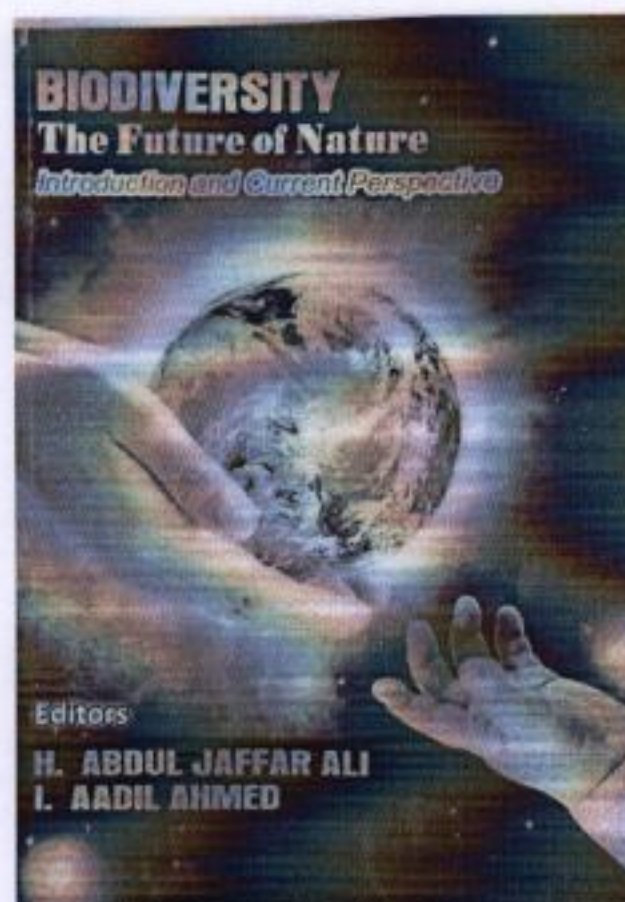

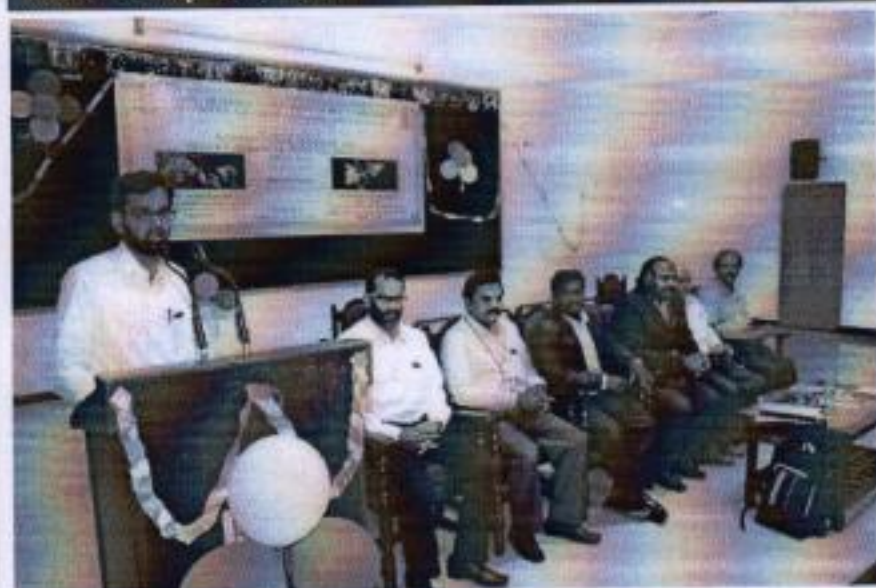

Background

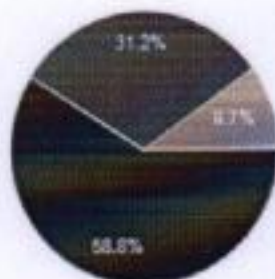

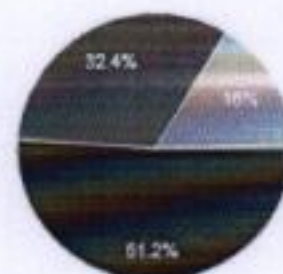

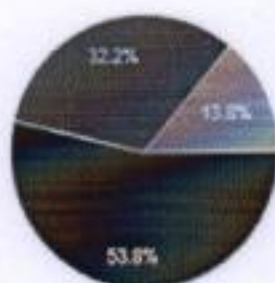

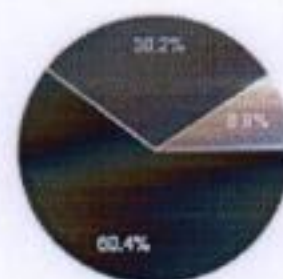

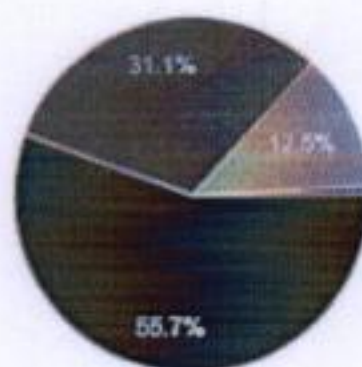

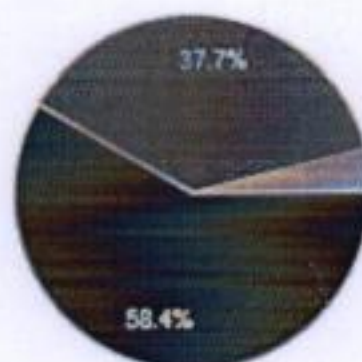


Report on the Hands-on training program for the U.G. students of Chemistry


