





Report of the Field Visit of Keeladi on 01-04-2022 & 02-04-2022 by M.A. History Students

Fifteen M. A. History students of our department along with the staff members Dr. K. Murugan, Mr. P. Basith Assarani and Dr. Mohammed Osman Pasha, Assistant Professors of History visited the Archaeological sites at Keeladi and visited the historical places at Pudukottai, Tanjore and Tiruchirappalli as per the schedule. The students and staff members assembled in our college campus and started their journey on 31st March, 2022 by 08:30.P.M through a 20-seater van. Our Principal, Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, supervised and inspected the necessary arrangements for a trip and advised our students about the precautionary measures and discipline students should follow in the tourist places and he insisted on the importance of the field visit as a part of the education before sending off our students. We started our journey from our campus and reached Madurai by next day morning on 01st of April, 2022, after visiting the Madurai local. We reached keeladi excavation spot by the same day evening.

Day-I (01-04-2022) - KEELADI

The group of 15 students along with 03 staff members visited 2200 years old Archaeological excavation site at Keeladi. Our students witnessed the four excavation trenches of the seventh phase of the excavation site at Keeladi. The unclosed archaeological pit unveiled the knowledge of our students practically apart from the books and classroom teaching. The students learned about the excavation procedures, measurements and the procedure for digging out the remains without any disturbance of its original form. Our students got a chance to visit the displayed remains of the eighth excavation trench. The variety of red ware remains of pottery sherds are displayed from the abovesaid eighth excavation site. After visiting the excavation trenches at Keeladi the students and staff members are stayed at Madurai to continue their journey for next day morning.

Ay-II (01-04-2022) FIRST VISIT - CITHANNAVASAL

The second day historical field trip was started with visiting Art Gallery in Rock-cut Jain temple at Chithannavasal nearby Pudukottai on the way to Tanjore by morning. Our students with the responsible staff members visited the Art Gallery at Rock-cut Jana temple called as Arivar-Kovil belong to the Pandya Kings Maran Sendan and Arikesari Maravarman whose reign from 7th to 8th centuries. The students enjoyed visiting the famous historical fresco paintings, samanar padukkai, stone carvings at roof, pillars, pilasters, sanctum; sitting posture of 24th Tirthankara's statue, brightest colorful murals on the upper parts of the cave etc., The students enjoyed the trip and got an additional practical information about the particular historical site in Chithannavasal. After visiting Chithannavasal our educational tourist group moved towards Tanjore Periya Kovil.

SECOND VISIT - TANJORE PERIYA KOVIL

We reached Tanjore Periya Kovil by the same day approximately 11:00.a.m. The students enjoyed visiting the Architectural splendor of the Cholas and studied the techniques used to construct the temple walls and the Gopura. Our students visited and astonished about the grand structures of Nandhi, Sculptures erected by Raja Raja Chola thousand years before. The students witnessed the astonishing fact about the 25 tones weighed single granite stone. The students learned about the Dravidian style of Architecture splendor and knew the differences between styles of Architecture followed in south and north during medieval Tamilagam. We departed from Tanjore after lunch and reached Kallanai at Truchrappalli by evening.

THIRD VISIT - KALLANAI DAM (or) GRAND ANICUT

Our educational tourists reached Kallanai, a Grand Ancut at Truchirappalli approximately by 04:00. P.M.The students witnessed the Ancient Dam constructed by the early Chola King Karikalan between 100A.D to 150.A.D. The students learned about the engineering wonder of the Ancient Tamil peoples through this field visit. This field visit witnessed our students to knew about the importance gave by our Tamil rulers to irrigation on Cauvery river bed and their peoples welfare measures through this standing example. The students visited "MANMANDAPAM", a memorial place for Karikala Cholan by the then Tamil Nadu Government and learned the entire history of that particular King and region through the portrayed colorful paintings and wall hangings. After visiting the last phase of our Historical Field Visit, our team of students and staffs are concluded their trip and reached our college campus at Vaniyambadi by the same day night means the starting of the next day (03rd April, 2022 by 01:00. A.M. the students from long distance are halted in our college owned Guest House along with our staff members and departed by the dawning of the day.


Report on Sapling Plantation Programme at Thumberi Village on 15.08.2021 to commemorate the 75th Indian Independence Day.





All our NSS Volunteers, students and office bearers of the programme were took pledge along with our beloved Principal to follow the Road Safety and Traffic Rules.





Background

SARS-CoV-2 has caused a worldwide health and social crisis, primarily because of the large number of deaths and the heavy pressure on healthcare systems due to so many individuals being hospitalized and in need of intensive care. Surveillance data shows that up to 90% of deaths and 80% of hospitalizations have occurred in older adults and persons with underlying conditions. From a societal perspective, if these groups were to be effectively protected against severe COVID-19, there would be a substantial decrease in bed occupancy and deaths and the pressure on the healthcare system would be significantly reduced. If the initial objective of the vaccination strategy is to exit emergency status, the vaccination of all older adults is the most efficient and effective approach. Societal and health problems caused by COVID-19 would be far from over but the instigating factor for the unprecedented global hiatus would be removed. As this vaccination approach is implemented, effective non-pharmaceutical interventions should be maintained, since transmission and disease will continue and other vulnerable groups will still be at risk. The identification and characterization of emerging variants of concern remains important.






Doctor checking blood pressure before vaccination



















Outcome


Faculty members receiving the second dose of Covishield Vaccine








Deworming Campaign

24th and 25th September 2021

Background

Four main species of intestinal worms (also known as soil-transmitted helminths) affect almost a quarter of the world's poorest and mostly marginalized people are the most affected. They are a major public health problem because the worms disrupt people's ability to absorb nutrients, impeding the growth and physical development of millions of children.

More than 836 million children are at risk of parasitic worm infections worldwide. According to World Health Organization 241 million children between the ages of 1 and 14 years are at risk of parasitic intestinal worms in India, also known as Soil-Transmitted Helminths (STH). Helminths (worms) which are transmitted through soil contaminated with faecal matter are called soil-transmitted helminths (Intestinal parasitic worms). Roundworm (Ascaris lumbricoides), whipworm (Trichuris trichiura) and hookworms (Necator americanus and Ancylostoma duodenale) are worms that infect people. Worm infestations contribute to vitamin A deficiency; deworming reduces anaemia, anaemia is also associated with increased vitamin A deficiency. Therefore, worm infestations and vitamin A deficiency both have serious health repercussions for a growing child and therefore both should be prioritized. STH is transmitted in the following ways.

- 1. Adult worms live in human intestines for food and survival and produce thousands of eggs each day.
- 2. Eggs are passed in the faeces of infected person.
- 3. Infected people who defecate outdoors spread worm eggs in the soil.
- 4. Eggs contaminate the soil and spread infection in several ways: -
- 5. Ingested through vegetables that are not carefully cooked, washed or peeled;
- Ingested from contaminated water sources;
- 7. Ingested by children who play in soil and then put their hands in their mouths without washing them.

STH infections can lead to anemia, malnutrition, impaired mental and physical & cognitive development, and reduced school participation. Periodic deworming programmes with a single-tablet treatment can drastically reduce the suffering of those infected with parasitic intestinal worms and protect the 1.5 billion people currently estimated to be at risk.




Objectives of the Campaign:

- > To deworm all students
- > To reduce the prevalence of soil transmitted Helminths (STH)
- > To reduce Vitamin A deficiency due to worm infestation
- > To overcome malnutrition and anaemia

Executive summary of the Campaign

With the blessings of Almighty, "Deworming Campaign" was organized by Islamiah College (Autonomous), Vaniyambadi, in collaboration with the Health Department, Government of Tamil Nadu, on 24th and 25th September 2021 to deworm students of age group less than 19 years. Deworming Tablets Albendazole 400 mg was obtained from the Health Department, Government of Tamil Nadu. Dr. N. Shabeer Ahmed, Assistant Professor, Department of Biotechnology planned and executed the campaign meticulously. A circular from the table of the Principal was circulated in this regard to the HoDs to distribute the deworming tablets to students through their mentors. A total of 1775 tablets were distributed. On 24.09.2021, 900 tablets were distributed to students and on 25.09.2021, 875 tablets were distributed.



Outcome and Suggestions

- Deworming will improve immunity, and thereby protect from chronic illnesses caused by worms.
- > It will improve concentration and attendance, making them more productive in classes.
- > It will increase nutritional uptake and control infections such as anemia, loose bowels, etc.
- > It will improve work potential and livelihood opportunity.
- > It will help in reducing worm infection in the community.

This campaign for the students, received appreciations from the College management, Health Department, Government of Tamil Nadu and the general public. After the success of this camp, it was suggested to deworm adults (above 19 years) as well under the guidelines of health professionals.






Road side cleaning: Ponneri - ELAGIRI ROAD


It is a promise to not only treat people affected with leprosy with but to also against the discrimination of leprosy.








