MINUTES OF 21st ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING

Held on 07-05-2026 at 11-30 a.m.

7th May 2026

The 21st Meeting of the Academic Council of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi was held on 07-05-2026 at 11-30 a.m. through blended mode. The meeting commenced with invocation by **Mr. P. Tanveer Ahmed**, HoD of Urdu & Arabic.

Mr. C. Khaizer Ahmed, Governing Body Nominee and Secretary and Correspondent of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi, welcomed the members of the newly constituted Academic Council and expressed gratitude to the efforts of previous members and all stakeholders in the development of college. He further brought to the notice of members that the college which has been serving the society for more than 107 years has always adopted latest technologies and updated its Curriculum, Infrastructure and Teaching methods.

Dr. T. Afsar Basha, chairman of the Academic Council, read the minutes of the 20th Academic Council Meeting held on 09-04-2025, which were approved unanimously by the house.

Dr. Syed Tahir Hussainy, Member Secretary, Academic Council & Vice-Principal (Administration), moved the resolution that the Regulations, NEP & IKS integrated Course Structure and Scheme of Examinations under the CBCS pattern for various UG Degree Programmes for Semesters I to VI & for various PG Degree Programmes for Semesters I to IV as given in Regulations and Schemes - Volume XX be adopted for implementation from the Academic Year 2026-2027 for students admitted from the Academic Year 2026-2027.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, Governing Body Nominee, praised the course structure for its holistic coverage of UGC & TANSCH requirements. He suggested a course on Climate

Change be included as per the directions of Judiciary. **Dr. T. Afsar Basha**, Chairman, welcomed the suggestion and assured that topics on climate change shall be included in the Syllabus of Environmental Studies, which is bound to be revised in the next Board of Studies.

Dr. G. Yoganandham and Dr. R. Vijayaragavan, University Nominees enquired about the course on Health, Wellness & Extension Activity. **Dr. Syed Tahir Hussainy**, Member Secretary, explained that it is a mandatory course for all UG & PG Degree Programmes as per the directions of Government of Tamilnadu and the assessment shall be carried out accordingly, and has been explained in the page numbers 5 and 74 for UG & PG students respectively, in the Regulations and Schemes - Volume XX. The University Nominees lauded the move and the resolution was approved.

Chairman, Board of Studies of all Departments moved the resolution for adoption of Syllabi (integrated with TANSCH model Syllabus) for I & II Semesters of UG & PG Degree Programmes for students admitted from Academic Year 2026-2027 as given in the Syllabi Book – Vol. XX.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, Governing Body Nominee suggested the inclusion of topics on Academic Databases, Data Management Softwares, Plagiarism, Research Ethics in Syllabi of PG Degree Programme and to encourage PG students to present and publish Research Articles. **Dr. S. Jafar Sathik**, Assistant Controller of Examinations, supported the suggestion and said that they shall be included in the next syllabi revision.

The resolution was approved unanimously.

Dr. K. Nazar Husen, Associate Professor of English, moved the resolution for adoption of Syllabus of Skill Developing Value Added Certificate Course, 'The Art of Effective Communication' to be offered by Department of English as given in the Syllabi Book – Vol. XX, from the Academic Year 2026-27, and it was resolved to approve the same.

Dr. P. Govindaraju, Associate Professor of Mathematics, moved the resolution for adoption of revised Syllabus of Skill Developing Value Added Certificate Course, 'Tourism and Travel Management' offered by PG & Research Department of History,

as given in the Syllabi Book – Vol. XX, from the Academic Year 2026-27, and it was resolved to approve the same.

Dr. M. Sayeeduddeen, Assistant Professor of Urdu, moved the resolution for adoption of Syllabus of Skill Developing Value Added Certificate Course, 'Indian Constitution' to be offered by PG & Research Department of History, as given in the Syllabi Book – Vol. XX, from the Academic Year 2026-27, and it was resolved to approve the same.

Dr. V. Mahmudul Hasan, Assistant Professor of Commerce, moved the resolution for adoption of Syllabi of Skill Developing Value Added Certificate Courses, 'Corporate Skills Development' and 'Receivables and Payables Management' to be offered by PG & Research Department of Commerce, as given in the Syllabi Book – Vol. XX, from the Academic Year 2026-27, and it was resolved to approve the same.

Mr. S. Mohammed Naseeruddeen, Controller of Examinations, moved that the Examination Manual Vol. XIX, be adopted for implementation from April 2026 Even Semester Examinations.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, Governing Body Nominee suggested inclusion of innovative tools and technology, such as Digital Examinations, Result Analytics, on-Screen Evaluation, FDP focussed on Examination reforms. **Mr. S. Mohammed Naseeruddeen**, Controller of Examinations, replied that Result Analytics are available in the College's ERP software and Digital Examinations for Objective Assessment based Courses are already being conducted using Digital Proctoring enabled Test Portal developed by Examination Cell of our college, Whereas to fully implement On-Screen Evaluations, it would take time. He further said that IQAC has been conducting FDP regularly and in future, as per the suggestions of **Dr. J. Srinivasan**, FDP specialised on Assessment and Evaluation shall be conducted.

Dr. R. Vijayaragavan, University Nominee, enquired whether the Bloom's Taxonomy is used for Question Paper Setting, to which **Mr. S. Mohammed Naseeruddeen**, Controller of Examinations, replied in affirmative.

The Examination Manual Vol. XIX was approved by all the members unanimously.

Dr. S. Jafar Sathik, Assistant Controller of Examinations, placed the results of the Autonomous Even Semester Examinations April 2025, and Odd Semester Examinations November 2025, for ratification and approval and it was resolved to ratify and approve the same by the august House unanimously.

Dr. C. Dhandapani, University Nominee, suggested increasing the moderation marks from 5 to 12. After discussion with the other members, it was decided to discuss it later, in depth, at College Development Council, before implementing it.

Mr. S. Mohammed Naseeruddeen, Controller of Examinations, brought forward the resolution for adoption of Uniform Question Paper Pattern as recommended by the College Development Council for Examinations of all Theory courses (of all current & previous batches) of both UG & PG Degree Programmes from the Academic Year 2026-2027 and was unanimously approved by all the members.

The meeting came to end at 1.00 p.m. with a formal vote of thanks by the **Dr. Shaik Khader Nawaz**, Vice-Principal [Academics] and Coordinator, IQAC.
