The IQAC, Islamiah College (Autonomous) Vaniyambadi has started the practice of conducting Internal Academic Audit (IAA) from 2014 with the help of Two Internal Academic Auditors namely Dr. S. Raja Mohamed Kamil, Associate Professor of Chemistry and Dr. A. Noor Mohamed, Associate Professor and HOD of Commerce. The period of Internal Academic Audit for which the present report has been submitted is from 01-01-2014 to 31-12-2104 i.e., the academic performance of two semesters. The Internal Academic Audit has been submitted under criteria wise covering all important aspects. The IAA process was started on 16.02.2015 and completed on 26.02.2015. The Internal Academic Auditors has prepared the report by personally visiting all the departments and collecting necessary information relating to their respective departments.

## I - CURRICULUM DESIGN

The designing of curriculum is the fundamental and foremost part of Academic structure. Curriculum is designed with the aim of keeping pace with the modern day advancement as well as providing employment opportunities to the students. The autonomy of this college gives free hand to design our own curriculum to fulfill the above requirements and thereby enabling us to produce graduates anchored with outstanding skills and leadership qualities.

In BBA, the most wanted subjects like 'Advertisement and Salesmanship' and 'Tally and Export Management' have been introduced.

In B.Com (C.A), the topics teaching the recruitment procedure of UPSC, TNPSC AND RRB and training methods of leading companies like TCS, WIPRO, PEPSI are included in the syllabus.

In B.Com (F&A), the curriculum design concentrates on training the students in the field of financial services, accounting and auditing.

In B.Com, the new papers such as 'Recent trends in Banking and Technological development in Banking' and 'Recent trends in Marketing' have been introduced. In M.com, the topic 'Human resource accounting and social responsibility accounting' is introduced in 'Advanced Accounting' paper.

In B.A (History), the papers including 'General Knowledge and Awareness' and 'Civil Services and other competitive examinations have been introduced in III and IV semesters respectively.

In B. Sc (Mathematics), the paper 'Hands on training with computer' has been introduced in the curriculum.

In both the under graduate and post graduate courses of Chemistry, practical skills are honed by introducing semester wise practical examinations. Industry oriented topics have become the part of the syllabus. Modern teaching methods through multimedia classes are being adopted.

In Biochemistry course, the job oriented 'medical lab technology' paper is introduced in V semester of under graduation and 'nano biochemistry' has been introduced at post graduate level.

In Biotechnology, the papers consist of skill based subjects such as aquaculture biotechnology; human pathology, vermicomposting etc have been introduced. The papers such as medical biotechnology, nano biotechnology are given as electives. In M.Sc biotechnology, the optional subjects are immunotechnology, aquaculture technology etc.

In designing the Tamil syllabi, the emphasis was given for moral literature and the articles of eminent persons are also included to boost the self-confidence of the students.

The department of English has prepared text books for II B.A/B. Sc students.

# II -INTER DISCIPLINARY PROGRAMMES

BBA department offers Management subjects dealing with Training and development and Employees to the students of other departments.

B.Com (CA) offers Income Tax as non-major subject to BBA students to make them aware of basic principles of IT.

The Commerce department conducts add on courses such as Certificate Course in E-Commerce and footwear technology for 40 students from all departments and Computer Applications in business is offered to history department students as Non-Major subject.

History department offers Indian National movement and Indian political system as nonmajor papers for B.Com and B.Com (FA) students.

The Physics department offers subjects like 'Fundamental of Electrical and Electronic measurements' and 'Maintenance of Home Appliances' as non-major subjects for the students of B.Com (FA) and B. Sc (Mathematics) students.

The Computer Science department offers 'Introduction to IT' and 'Internet and its Applications' for III semester and IV semester students of other department students.

The Department of Chemistry conducts inter disciplinary research with the Physics department leading to the award of PhD degrees to the faculty members of Physics.

Biochemistry department has introduced diagnostic biochemistry for B. Sc Biotechnology students.

The department of English offers 'English for communication 'for B. Sc computer Science students of III Semester and 'Business writing in English' for IV semester students.

## III-EXAMINATION REFORMS

The internal marks have been divided under three categories of tests, assignments and attendance. Out of 25 marks, 15 marks for CIA tests I & II, 05 marks for assignment and 05 marks are allotted for attendance.

The Office of the Controller of Examinations has introduced the system of Computed Generated Random Dummy Numbers for the Autonomous Examinations in order to maintain confidentiality and transparency. Similarly the OMR Mark Sheet has been introduced in order to speed up the process of results publication.

# IV- FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The staff members of all the departments periodically participate and present papers in Seminars, Symposia and Conferences at State, National and International levels.

In BBA, Dr. M. Abdul Kader, secured Ph. D in commerce in 2014 and other three faculty members are pursuing Ph. D programme.

In B. Com (FA), Mr. M. A. Bilal Ahmed has submitted his Ph. D thesis. Mr. Srinivasan has submitted his Ph. D synopsis under the guidance of Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, Associate Professor of Commerce.

In B. Com Mr. V. Valeeullah has submitted his Ph. D synopsis and Mr. S. Mohammed Naseeruddeen is doing M. Phil (Part-Time) course. Dr. V. Mahmudul Hasan, Mr. S. Md. Naseeruddeeen, Dr. G. Azad Basha, Dr. D. S. A. Mehaboob and Mr. A. Khaleequssaman attended 28 day orientation programme..

In Physics department, Dr. Asgar has been awarded Ph. D and two other members are pursuing Ph. D (Part-Time) course.

In the department of Chemistry, M. A. Nazim Ahmed, submitted his Ph. D thesis. Mr. S. Jaffer Sathik and Mr. A. Sowkath submitted their synopses. Four more staff members go approval for M.Phil guideship from Thiruvalluvar University.

In Biochemistry, Dr. M. P. Asher Waheed completed Ph. D degree from Bharathia University, Coimbatore. Mr. V. Magendiramani is doing Ph. D, Part-time course and Mr A. Amjat Hussain has registered for M. Phil (part-time) in this college.

## X- GOOD PRACTICES OF THE DEPARTMENTS

The students of BBA are encouraged to participate in State and National level Seminars, Cultural programmes and competitions conducted in other colleges.

B.Com (CA) department conducts regular parent-teacher meeting to apprise the performances of the individual students. The practice of News paper reading is inculcated among the students to know the developments in stock exchange.

B.Com (FA) department encourages their students to learn computer technology by using laptops.

The department of Commerce maintains the departmental library containing books of 140 titles. These books are lent for the students to for prepare for examinations as well as for instant references.

The department of History offers counseling to the students regarding filling up of applications for competitive examinations and for preparations.

The department of Mathematics is guiding the students to appear for competitive examinations conducted by UPSC, TNPSC, UGC, CSIR etc. This department also conducts remedial classes for slow learners.

In the Physics department, a corpus fund has been created from contributions from the staff members to help the deserving poor students.

The department of Computer Science sends SMS alerts to the parents of the students about their attendance. It provides internet facility for students' project during leisure hours.

The department of Chemistry conducts regular remedial classes for poor performers and also run coaching classes for all competitive examinations. The students are encouraged to involve the activities of the forum, Rural Society for the Advancement of Chemistry, (RUSAC). The PG students are given first hand information and training to operate the sophisticated instruments in the laboratories, FIST I and FIST II.

The Biochemistry department utilizes the funds obtained from the alumni for the purchase of chemicals, kits etc. This department also plays the video lectures of the eminent persons during the leisure hours.

# XI-STUDENT ATTENDANCE

A minimum of 75% attendance is required to appear for both theory and practical examinations. The students with 65-74% of attendance are listed under shortage of attendance and they need to pay condonation fee to become eligible to write the examinations. The students who have 55-64% are detained and those with less than 55% have to redo the course.

Nearly 85% of the students have attendance over 75%. Almost all the remaining students pay the condonation fee and write the examination.

#### XII- RESULT ANALYSIS

The overall results of the students in all the departments are fairly good. However, the papers which need to be concentrated are mentioned here.

BBA April-2014 In first year, the result of 'Banking & Financial system' is 45% and in II BBA the results of 'Financial Management (Allied)' is 46%.

Nov-2014 In I year, the pass percentage of 'Principles of Management' is 41% and that of 'Business Organization' is mere 30%.

B.COM (CA) April-2014 In the paper, 'Corporate Accounting II', the result was 46%.

Nov-2014 In the first year 'Principles of Management', the percentage of result is 40%. In the second year, the papers, 'Corporate Accounting I' and 'Data base management system' have the pass percentages of 40% and 11% respectively. In Third year, 'Banking law & practice' has the pass percentage of 31% and the Web Technology has 44%.

B.COM (FA) Nov-2014 In Second year B.com, 38% of the students have passed in the paper 'Business Statistics', 22% of the students have passed in 'Modern Banking' and 26% of the students have passed in 'Managerial Economics'. In Third year, the pass percentages of the papers, 'Business Communication' and 'Elements of Insurance' are 38 and 39 respectively.
