Teachers' Feedback Analysis for the Academic Year 2020-21

The Teachers' Feedback for the Academic Year 2020-21 was collected from all the Teaching Faculty Members of the College by administering a well structured questionnaire consisting of 20 questions in the form of statements and suggestions for the quality enhancement and development of our institutions. Analysis of the Teachers' Feedback for the Academic Year 2020-21 is presented below:

- 93% of respondents strongly agree that the curriculum is designed to ensure overall development of students.
- A vast majority of teachers strongly agree that the Academic Work is planned at the start of each semester and work diary is used by all the faculty members for the accomplishment of the Academic Work planned.
- 84% of teachers strongly agree that the syllabi revision is carried out regularly to include the current topics.
- 79% of teachers rated as strongly agree with course/subject taught are up to date and relevant to present day world and 21% teachers are rated as agree.
- 79% of teachers strongly agree that courses/subjects taught are up to date and relevant to present day world.
- Most of the teachers strongly agree that the courses/subjects have the ability to enhance the skill and knowledge of the students.
- Most of the teachers are strongly agreeing on course relevance to job competence.
- The results found that 64% of teachers are strongly agreeing with imparting of moral & ethical values along with the concepts and principles of their domain.
- Majority of Teachers are responded that emphasis is given for improving communication skills of students.
- 90% of teachers responded that college motivates teachers to use the innovative teaching methods for teaching learning experience.
- The analysis found that 87% of teachers strongly agree that college offers ICT

facilities.

- 87% of teachers strongly agree that college allows/encourages teachers to attend seminars, workshops and conferences to further hone skills towards design and delivery of courses.
- The results found that 78% of teachers strongly agree that the views and opinions of students' representative, alumni, industrialist & subjects experts are duly considered and incorporated while designing and framing syllabus.
- It can be seen from the responses that 85% of teachers strongly agree with outcome based education and acknowledge that POs, PSOs and Cos are communicated to the students.
- The responses reveal that 62% of teachers strongly agree that college provides the facility of media centre to record and edit the video lectures.
- The data shows that 78% of teachers strongly agree that the curriculum offers a perfect blend of theory and practical.
- The results found that 77 teachers strongly agree that the college encourages the students to take part in extra curriculum and sports activities for their overall development.
- The analysis found that 75% of teachers strongly agree with industry –academia collaboration.
- 87% of teachers strongly agree that college celebrate the national days.
- Out of 97 respondents 93 strongly agree that the college is striving for achieving its vision and mission

Suggestions

Following are the suggestions of teachers:

- + Exclusive libraries for departments. .
- + It is better to provide competitive coaching centre and communicative English classes for the students in the college.
- + To introduce self study MOOCs Courses and Free Online Courses.
- + All the class rooms should be equipped with OHP to enable more ICT based teaching.

- + Forming of Research Association for Research Development.
- + More practical papers may be included in the curriculum.
