**Analysis Report of Students' Feedback for the Academic Year 2020-21**

The Students' Overall Feedback, for the Academic Year 2020-21, was collected through Google Form due to lockdown during September 2021. A well structured Online Feedback Form was administered to collect the Students' Feedback among the Second and Third Year UG Students and Second PG Students of the college. 953 students responded to the Feedback Form (Google Form). The following are the findings and observations:

**Findings and Observations**

- Out of the total of 953 student respondents, 476 (Approx. 50%) belong to II Year UG, 399 (Approx. 42%) belong to III Year UG.
- According to 53.6% of the respondents, Teachers' Preparation for the Classes was very well and according to 30.8 %, teachers were well prepared.
- Teacher's approach to teaching can be described as excellent for 41.1% of the respondents, very good for 28.1% and good for 27.9% of the respondents.
- 73% of the respondents opined that teachers are often helpful and advise quite often.
- Most of the students opined that the prescribed materials for the subjects are easily available.
- A Vast Majority of the students rated internal evaluation process as fair.
- Most of student respondents strongly agree that Teaching and Mentoring Process of the institution facilitates in overall development.
- Most of the students agree that the College provides multiple opportunities to learn and grow.
- A Vast Majority of the students agree that teachers inform students about expected competencies, course outcomes and programme outcome.
- For most of the students, mentor does a necessary follow-up for the assigned tasks.



- A great majority of the student respondents said that teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications every time.
- A vast majority of the students strongly agree that teachers identify student's strength and encourage them. Similarly, most of the students strongly agree that teachers identify the weakness of students and help them to overcome.
- Most of the students strongly agree that the Institution is taking effort to engage students in monitoring, reviewing and continuous quality improvement of the teaching learning process.
- A great majority of the students strongly agree that teachers use different methods of teaching for enhancing learning experiences.
- Most of the students agree to a greater extent that efforts are made by the institution/teachers to inculcate Soft Skills, Life Skills and Employability Skills to make you ready for the world of work
- The overall Quality of Teaching-Learning Process in the institution is very good for a vast majority of students.
- The service of the College Office and Office of the COE can be best described as very good for majority of students.

### Suggestions


Based on the above findings and observations, the following suggestions were made by IQAC to further enhance the Quality of Teaching – Learning Experience:
