**INTRODUCTION**

The External Academic Audit, of Islamiah College (Autonomous), for the Academic Year 2024-25 was conducted on 11.04.2025, The External Academic Auditors, Dr. T. MOHAMED ILYAS, Former Principal of Islamiah College (Autonomous) & NAAC Peer Team Member and Dr. C. DHANDAPANI, Principal, KMG Arts & Science College, Gudiyattam, conducted the External Academic Audit.

The objective of the External Academic Audit is to assess the effectiveness and efficiency of Academic and Administrative processes and to ensure that Academic Departments and Support Services comply with applicable rules, regulations, policies, guidelines, standards and focus on continuous improvements.

The standard procedure of External Academic Audit includes a physical inspection and review of the relevant documents of the Academic Departments and Support Services, meetings and abstract information obtained from the relevant Academic Departments as well as a review of the Internal Academic Audit Report conducted by the Internal Academic Auditors.
