

MINUTES OF 16th ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING



Held on 14-07-2022 at 11-30 am. through blended mode

14th July 2022

The 16th Academic Council Meeting of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi was held on 14-07-2022 at 11-30 a.m. through blended mode. The meeting commenced with prayer by Mr. P. Tanveer Ahmed, Head, Department of Urdu & Arabic.

The Secretary and Correspondent of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi, Mr. L. M. Muneer Ahmed, welcomed the members of the Academic Council and thanked all the stakeholders of the College for the completion of twelve years of autonomy. He shared to the members that the Education World Magazine has ranked our college 80th place at the National level, and 33rd place at the Tamil Nadu State level, among the Top 500 Autonomous Arts & Science Colleges of India. He brought to the knowledge of members, recent developments in the College such as new laboratories, ICT classrooms, and physical facilities such as a lab sewage treatment plant, herbal garden, mushroom hut, and new buildings for Physical Education and Gymnasium etc. He also appreciated the efforts of IQAC in conducting various programmes for the enhancement of quality, such as the 'Enhancing and Sustaining Quality in Higher Education through New Accreditation Framework of NAAC,' 'Role of Assessment and Accreditation in Enhancing & Sustaining Quality of Higher Educational Institutions', 'Reforms in New Accreditation Framework of NAAC', 'Process of New Accreditation Framework of NAAC & New AQAR Format', 'Publishing Research Articles in Peer-Reviewed Journals - A Right Approach', 'Mapping and Attainment of Learning Outcomes,". He commended the efforts of the office of COE for the smooth functioning of examination and evaluation works, especially the fair evaluation, timely publication of results, and new up-gradation of the COE office.

Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, chairman, of the meeting, read the minutes of the 15th Academic Council Meeting and was approved by the house.

Dr. A. Liyakath Ali, Head of the Department of Biochemistry, moved the Regulations and Schemes of Examinations for various UG & PG programmes for the semester I & II as given in Regulations and Schemes - Vol. XV and it was resolved to approve the same with effect from the academic year 2022-2023 and thereafter.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, External Expert, praised the regulation for its holistic approach and commented that it is in line with the latest Education Policy.

Chairman, Board of Studies of all the Departments moved the Syllabi for I & II Semesters of all UG & PG Programmes for students admitted from Academic Year 2022-2023 and it was resolved to approve the same unanimously.

Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, Chairman, informed the gathering that the affiliation for its newly introduced B.Sc. Data Science Degree Programme has been received just two days before the meeting and the College has decided to follow the Syllabi of Theory & Practical of Core and Allied courses of Thiruvalluvar University, with common course structure of other degree programmes of the College for students admitted in the academic year 2022-2023 only, as the Board of Studies could not be conducted in the absence of a University Nominee.

Dr. U. Rizwan, Head of the Department of Mathematics, raised objection to the inclusion of allied courses 'Computer Oriented Statistical Methods I', 'Computer Oriented Statistical Methods II' and 'Computer Oriented Statistical Methods Practical' in the first and second semesters of B.Sc. Computer Science, and BCA, by the Department of Computer Science, as the workload for the same, is allotted to the Department of Mathematics, and the course title and syllabus are to be approved by the Board of Studies of Mathematics. Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, the Chairman, suggested to Prof. P. Magizhan, Head of the Department of Computer Science, that the Courses, 'Mathematical Foundations I', 'Mathematical Foundations II', 'Mathematical Foundations Practical', as passed in the Board of Studies of Mathematics be followed for this Academic Year 2022-2023. Further, the Chairman requested Dr. U. Rizwan, Head of the Department of Mathematics, to consider the inclusion of allied courses for B.Sc. Computer Science in the next meeting of the Board of Studies in Mathematics in consultation with Prof. P. Magizhan, Head of the Department of Computer Science.

Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, Chairman, brought to the notice of the gathering, that the Department of Tamil has newly introduced courses, 'Ithazhial I' and 'Ithazhial II' as Non-Major Courses for students of B.A. and B.Sc. Degree Programmes, in the semesters III and IV, for the students admitted from the Academic Year 2022-2023. This shall be helpful in enhancing the employability skills in the field of Journalism. He further added that 'Ithazhial' has also been stressed in the New Education Policy - 2020, and it is introduced as PG Degree Programme, 'M.A. Journalism and Mass Communication - Tamil' by IGNOU.

Dr. A. Mohamed Ali, Associate professor of Mathematics, moved the syllabi for the additional Value-added Certificate Courses introduced by the following departments from the academic year 2022-2023.

Dr. Syed Tahir Hussainy, Associate Professor of Mathematics, moved the new three hours question paper pattern for the students admitted from the academic year 2022-2023 for both UG and PG Programmes.

- **Dr. A. Sait Sahul Hameed,** External Expert, enquired whether it would be possible to complete the examination on time, to which the Chairman answered in the affirmative.
- Dr. J. Srinivasan, External Expert, asked whether any model test under the new pattern has been conducted. Dr. F. Liakath Ali Khan, Member Secretary & Controller of Examinations, answered that, though we have not yet conducted any model test, a similar model is being successfully practiced in many top-ranked institutions.
- Dr. A. Sait Sahul Hameed, External Expert, opined that time be provided to students for the reading question paper. All members unanimously agreed on the same and decided to provide Ten Minute duration before the commencement of the Examination, i.e. 9.50 am to 10.00 am for Forenoon session and 1.50 pm to 2.00 pm for Afternoon session.
- **Dr. C. Dhandapani,** University Representative, requested for a change in the proposed Question Paper Pattern. After a long deliberation, the members agreed upon the following Question Paper Pattern as suggested by the Chairman:

Part A (15 MCQs of 1 mark each)	15 × 1 = 15 Marks
Part B (5 Short Answer Questions of 3 marks each)	5 × 3 = 15 Marks
Part C (5 Either or type Questions of 5 marks each)	5 × 5 = 25 Marks
Part D (3 Out of 5 Questions of 10 marks each)	3 × 15 = 45 Marks
Total (3 hours duration)	100 Marks*

Mohamed Ilyas**, Chairman, replied that the efforts are already underway and requested cooperation from the authorities of Thiruvalluvar University, Vellore in forwarding the application. **Dr. C. Dhandapani**, University Representative, assured that Thiruvalluvar University would definitely assist the college in this regard.

Dr. C. Dhandapani, University Representative, stressed to organise Centenary Celebrations, adding that it is really a remarkable feat to excel in the field of Education for over a century.

Dr. U. Rizwan, Head of the Department of Mathematics, praised the innovative efforts of the office of Controller of Examinations in conducting Examinations and Evaluation of Answer Scripts. He said that the online facility for students to view their Hall number and Seat number through the student login portal on our college website half an hour before the commencement of Examinations for the benefit of the students. He further said that the facility to enter marks of evaluated answer scripts of End Semester Autonomous Examinations through Intranet was convenient and error-free for the examiners and instrumental for the publication of results within three days from the last day of examinations.

Mr. D. Abul Fazal, Head of the Department of History, moved the resolution to condole the sudden and sad demise of Dr. P. Basith Assarani, Assistant Professor of History, who passed away on 08.07.2022. All members observed one-minute silence as a mark of respect to the departed soul.
