



## ISLAMIAH COLLEGE [AUTONOMOUS], VANIYAMBADI MINUTES OF 17th ACADEMIC COUNCIL MEETING Held on 23-01-2023 at 11-30 am. through blended mode



23<sup>rd</sup> July 2023

The 17<sup>th</sup> Academic Council Meeting of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi was held on 23-01-2023 at 11-30 a.m. through blended mode. The meeting commenced with prayer by Mr. P. Tanveer Ahmed, Head, Department of Urdu & Arabic.

The Secretary and Correspondent of Islamiah College [Autonomous], Vaniyambadi, Mr. L. M. Muneer Ahmed, welcomed the members of the Academic Council and thanked all the stakeholders of the College for the completion of thirteen years of autonomy. He shared with the members about the 'Herbal Mask Patent' for COVID prevention designed by Dr. NPM Md. Thariq and Dr. S. U. Md. Riaz of Biotechnology, which has been registered by the Patent Office, Government of India. He also mentioned the 'Best Green Campus Award' received for Environment and Energy audit by the Nature Science Foundation, Coimbatore, which is valid till 2025 and implementation of Chief Minister's Naan Mudhalvan Scheme for the first four Semesters for all the UG programmes. He further stated about ongoing NAAC reaccreditation preparatory works.

- Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, Chairman, of the meeting, read the minutes of the 16th Academic Council Meeting and was approved by the house. Further, he introduced the newly nominated University representatives by the Thiruvalluvar University and External Experts outside the college by the Institution for a period of three years.
- Dr. S. Raja Md. Kamil, Head of the Department of Chemistry, moved the "Regulations and Schemes" - Vol. XVI (Course Structure and Examination details under CBCS pattern) for Semesters III & IV of various UG & PG Programmes for the candidates admitted from the academic year 2022-2023 and it was approved by the august house.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, External Expert, praised the framework of Regulation & Schemes and terminology used for course categories, and mapping techniques are in line with the latest Education Policy.

Chairman, Board of Studies of all the Departments moved the Syllabi for III & IV Semesters of all UG & PG Programmes for students admitted from Academic Year 2022-2023 and it was resolved to approve the same unanimously.

Dr. A. Sait Sahul Hameed, External Expert elaborated on the importance of Agricultural Biotechnology and suggested for introduction in the Discipline Specific Core Course of the UG Biotechnology Programme from the next regulations. Dr. H. Abdul Jaffar Ali, Head of the Department of Biotechnology has appreciated the importance to implement the same in the V or VII Semester of the UG Biotechnology Programme.

Dr. Chitra, University Representative, from Thiruvallur University, referred to page No. 56 of Regulations & Schemes and pointed out the repeated contents of two core courses namely Integral Transforms and Special Transforms for which Dr. U. Rizwan, the Head of the Department of Mathematics responded by providing the contents of two core courses in Syllabi Book, Volume XVI are not repeated and this suggestion was resolved.

Dr. S, Ismail Mohideen, External Expert suggested introducing the Fuzzy Sets in Mathematic programme as a specific Core course instead of in Discipline Specific Elective course for the UG Mathematics Programme and also suggested its implementation in the PG Mathematics Programmes.

Dr. A. Sait Sahul Hameed, External Expert, raised the question of whether the Department of Biotechnology and Biochemistry are worked together on the course for Clinical Biochemistry, to which the Head of the Department of Biochemistry responded "Yes" and stated common classroom teaching and question paper are followed in the Semester Examination for both programmes, which has been appreciated.

The Secretary & Correspondent Mr. L.M. Muneer Ahmed stressed the importance of the Tamil language for College students. Dr. A. Sait Sahul Hameed, External Expert also acknowledged the importance of the Tamil language paper being compulsory in direct recruitment for Government posts.

Dr. A. Mohamed Ali, Associate professor of Mathematics, moved the syllabi for the Value-Based Courses (Online Exam) for Semesters III & IV of all UG Programmes for the students admitted from the academic year 2022-2023.

Dr. G. Yoganandham, University Representative, raised about some of the common courses in B. Com. General, B.Com. F.A, B.Com C.A and B.B.A, for which the Heads of B.Com. and B.B.A. departments responded about the necessity of certain basic common Courses for Commerce and Business administration students. Further, he suggested to implement Courses like Digital Administration, Budget Corporate Finance for B.Com. Commerce, B.Com Computer E-Goverence, Applications and B.B.A. programmes.

Dr. Syed Tahir Hussainy, Associate Professor of Mathematics moved the course structure to introduce Tamil and English Languages in the first four semesters for all UG students admitted from the academic year 2023-2024 and this will be implemented as and when the Tamil Nadu Government mandates the two-language and shall be compulsory for those students who are admitted from the academic year 2023-2024 and was approved by the house.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, External Expert stated the implementation of Tamil and English language guidelines by the Tamil Nadu Government is not clear and how the workload has to be shared. Dr. S, Ismail Mohideen, External Expert, intervened and explained that they have been following this scheme for a very long time in their Institution. **Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas,** Chairman of the Academic Council responded to implementing English and Tamil for the first four semesters of all the UG programmes for the students admitted from the academic year 2023-2024.

**Dr. F. Liakath** Ali Khan, Controller of Examinations moved the permission granted based on the respective HODs' recommendation to those final year students to complete the internship during college working hours if they have not completed their internship outside college working hours on an exceptional basis which has been approved by the august house.

Dr. A. Sait Sahul Hameed, External Expert raised a question about allowing students to an internship programme for a longer period during college working hours. Dr. T. Mohamed Ilyas, Chairman of the Academic Council responded that the permission granted to the students was based on the recommendation and undertaking from the Head of the respective department to complete the syllabus for the students who underwent the internship programme. Dr. Chitra, University Representative, Thiruvalluvar University suggested to allow the students during semester vacation to complete their internship programme. Dr. F. Liakath Ali Khan, the Controller of Examination pointed out that the guidelines for the internship programme are clearly stated in the Regulations and Schemes, the students are allowed to start their internship programme from the fourth-semester vacation onwards.

Dr. J. Srinivasan, External Expert clarified the doubt on page no. 16 of the Examination Manual, about the Instant Exam for one paper be taken only in the final semester or in any semester. Dr. F. Liakath Ali Khan, Controller of Examinations, answered that the instant exam is allowed only for final-year students that too in the final semester if he has an arrear in only one course irrespective of the semester. Further, he enquired about the E- verification of the Degree certificate by the institution or University. The Controller of Examination again clarified that Mark statements and Consolidated Marks statements are verified by the Institution and Degree certificate by the University.

**Dr. J. Srinivasan,** External Expert appreciated the facility provided by the Department of Examinations to the students to know their seat number and Examination Hall number through the student login portal half an hour before the commencement of the Semester examination on a particular session.

Dr. F. Liakath Ali Khan, Controller of Examinations, moved that the Examination Manual Vol. XV be adopted for implementation from April/May 2023 Even Semester Examination which was unanimously approved by the members.

Dr. F. Liakath Ali Khan, Controller of Examinations, placed the results of the Autonomous Odd Semester Examinations November/December 2022 for ratification and it was resolved to approve and ratify the same by the august House. The percentage of results which are very poor in some courses needs to be improved and the concerned chairman of the BOS has entrusted the responsibility to take remedial measures to improve the same in their department.

In any other academic matter discussion, Dr. K. Anandaratchagan, Associate Professor of Chemistry moved the resolution regarding the permission to be granted for registration to Academic Bank of Credits [ABC] by the college for digital storage and transfer of credits earned by the students and it was unanimously approved by the august house.

Mr. D. Abul Fazal, Head of the Department of History moved the resolution to condole the sudden and sad demise of Dr. Major Syed Shahabuddeen, Former Principal and Director of Non-Formal Education, V.M.E Society, who passed away on 31<sup>st</sup> August 2022. All members observed one-minute silence as a mark of respect for the departed soul.

The meeting came to an end at 1.00 p.m. with a formal vote of thanks by the Member Secretary and Controller of Examinations **Dr. F. Liakath Ali Khan**. The Secretary & Correspondent and Principal requested all the members to give their company in the delicious lunch.
